

On March 27, 1972, Dorothy O. Bogue filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in point of diversion and place of use of water from Wolf Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

Certificate of water right issued to Jesse L. Harris and recorded at page 20864, Volume 15, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of 0.005 cubic feet per second of the waters of Wolf Creek for the irrigation of 0.4 acre in NE% NW%, Section 22, Township 33 South, Range 6 West, W.M., with a date of priority of April 18, 1950. These lands are irrigated at a point of diversion located 580 feet South and 400 feet East from the NW corner of NE% NW%, being within the NE% of NW% of Section 22, Township 33 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

The application herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the place of use to the irrigation of 0.4 acre in NE% NW%, Section 22, Township 33 South, Range 6 West, W.M., more particularly described as four tracts of land within Lots 6, 10, and 11, Block F, Original Town of Wolf Creek, and irrigate these lands from a point of diversion to be located 670 feet South and 320 feet East from the NW corner of NE% NW%, being within the NE% NW% of Section 22, Township 33 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

Notice by publication as provided by ORS 540.520 was not given in connection with this application for the reason that said

section provides notice is not required on an application for a change in point of diversion of water of less than one-fourth mile where there are no intervening diversions.

Mr. Robert B. Steimer, Watermaster of District No. 14, has filed a report to the effect that the proposed change in place of use and point of diversion of water may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use and point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the change in place of use of water is approved and the water right hereinbefore described as appurtenant to 0.4 acre in NE% NW%, Section 22, Township 33 South, Range 6 West, W.M., with a date of priority of April 18, 1950, be severed therefrom and simultaneously and without loss of priority transferred to 0.4 acre in NE% NW%, Section 22, Township 33 South, Range 6 West, W.M., more particularly described as four tracts of land within Lots 6, 10 and 11, Block F, Original Town of Wolf Creek.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the proposed change in point of diversion of water from Wolf Creek, to-wit:

From a point located 580 feet South and 400 feet East from the NW corner of NE% NW%, being within the NE% NW% of Section 22, Township 33 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

To a point to be located 670 feet South and 320 feet East from the NW corner of NE% NW% being within the NE% NW% of Section 22, Township 33 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

for the irrigation of 0.4 acre in NE% NW%, Section 22, Township 33 South, Range 6 West, W.M., with a date of priority of April 18, 1950, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use and the change in point of diversion made on or before October 1, 1973.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water that is available at the old point of diversion and shall be limited to 0.005 cubic feet per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices.

That the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificate of water right heretofore issued to Jesse L. Harris and recorded at page 20864, Volume 15,

State Record of Water Right Certificates is canceled and upon receipt
of proof satisfactory to the State Engineer of completion of the
authorized change in point of diversion and place of use, a certificate of water right shall be issued to Dorothy O. Bogue confirming
the change in point of diversion and place of use.
