effective date prior to this right.

ORDER APPROVING  
TRANSFER NO. 2625

On April 10, 1972, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Olson-Lawyer Lumber, Inc., for approval of a change in place of use of water from unnamed No. 1 spring, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 15306, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of George L. Jantzer Lumber Co., Inc., describes a right for the use of not to exceed 0.07 cubic foot per second from an unnamed No. 1 spring for domestic purposes for 12 families in SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 10, Township 33 South, Range 2 East, W.M., with a date of priority of December 16, 1943.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 225 feet North and 700 feet West from the North Quarter Corner of Section 10, being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 3, Township 33 South, Range 2 East, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the water right above described, proposes to change, without loss of priority, the place of use from six certain single family units in SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 10, and in lieu thereof serve six additional single family units, being two families in NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , one family in SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , and three families in SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 10, Township 33 South, Range 2 East, W.M.

Mr. David C. Hendrix, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.


It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1979.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources



of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, the certificate of water right heretofore issued to George L. Jantzer Lumber Co., Inc., and recorded at page 15306, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, be canceled, and in lieu thereof a new confirming certificate of water right be issued to the applicant herein.
