

under Permit No.21264 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 25, 1952

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and he eby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said surposes, and shall not exceed 0.09 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW% NE%, Section 31, T. 5 S., R. 1 W., W. M., 930 feet North and 1480 feet West, 530 feet North and 1480 feet West, both from the E% Corner, Section 31

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

7.3 acres SW4 NE4 Section 31 T. 5 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered February 25, 1974 and supersedes certificate of water right recorded on page 22218, Volume 16, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

OF CLARENCE SCHLECHTER FOR THE APPROVAL OF A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE OF WATER FROM AN UNNAMED STREAM

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 2965

On January 25, 1974, Clarence Schlechter filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in place of use of water from an unnamed stream, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

Certificate of water right issued to Peter Schlechter and recorded at page 22218, Volume 16, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of not to exceed 0.09 cubic foot per second of water from an unmamed stream for the irrigation of, 7.3 acres in SW2 NE2, Section 31, Township 5 South, Range 1 West, W.M., with a date of priority of March 25, 1952. These lands are irrigated from points of diversion located (1) 930 feet North and 1480 feet West, and (2) 530 feet North and 1480 feet West from the East 2 corner of Section 31, both being within the SW2 NE2, Section 31, Township 5 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the land above described, proposes to transfer the water right therefrom, without loss of priority to 7.3 acres in SW2 NE2, Section 31, Township 5 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

Notice by publication as provided by ORS 540.520 was not given in connection with this application for the reason that said section provides notice is not required on an application for a change in place of use of water.

Mr. E. Michael Ricks, Watermaster of District No. 16, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the change in place of use of water is approved and the water right hereinbefore described as appurtenant to 7.3 acres in SW2 NE2, Section 31, Township 5 South, Range 1 West, W.M., with a date of priority of March 25, 1952, be severed therefrom and simultaneously and without loss of priority transferred to 7.3 acres in SW2 NE2, Section 31, Township 5 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1975.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificate of water right heretofore issued to Peter Schlechter and recorded at page 22218, Volume 16, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the State Engineer of application of water to beneficial use, a certificate of water right shall be issued to Clarence Schlechter confirming the extent to which the water has been applied beneficially.
