ORDER APPROVING
TRANSFER NO. 2981

On February 25, 1974, Audrey Z. Parsons filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in place of use of water from Rogue River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

By Decree of the Circuit Court for Jackson County, Oregon, entered May 19, 1964, In the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Rogue River and its Tributaries, a water right was established in the name of Audrey Z. Parsons for the use of the waters of Rogue River for the irrigation of, among other lands, 1.0 acre in Lot 3 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 8, and 2.0 acres in Lot 1 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 9, Township 35 South, Range 1 West, W.M., with a date of priority of 1892, as evidenced by certificate of water right recorded at page 32718, Volume 24, State Record of Water Right Certificates. These lands are irrigated from a point of diversion located 380 feet South and 830 feet West from the East $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Section 8, being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 8, Township 35 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the land above described, proposes to transfer the water right therefrom, without loss of priority, to 1.5 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, 0.6 acre in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 8, and 0.9 acre in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 9, Township 35 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

Notice by publication as provided by ORS 540.520 was not given in connection with this application for the reason that said section provides notice is not required on an application for a change in place of use of water.

Mr. David C. Hendrix, Watermaster of District No. 13, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the change in place of use of water is approved and the water right hereinbefore described as appurtenant to 1.0 acre in Lot 3 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 8, and 2.0 acres in Lot 1 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 9, Township 35 South, Range 1 West, W.M., with a date of priority of 1892, be severed therefrom and simultaneously and without loss of priority transferred to 1.5 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, 0.6 acre in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 8, and 0.9 acre in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 9, Township 35 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1976.

On January 3, 1973, an order was entered by the State Engineer confirming a change in place of use and a change in point of diversion. Said order canceled certificate 32718 and provided for the issuance of a superceding certificate.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that no new certificate of water right be issued as provided for by order of the State Engineer entered January 3, 1973, and upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the State Engineer of application of water to beneficial use, a certificate of water right shall be issued to Audrey Z. Parsons confirming the extent to which the water has been applied beneficially and including those lands not involved herein.

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 16, at page 523; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from 1892;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.03 cubic feet per
second.

The point of diversion is located in the Lot 3 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) Section 8, T. 35 S., R. 1 W., W.M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

2.0 acres in Lot 2 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$)

Section 8,

described as follows:

Commencing at the SE corner of said Lot 2, Sec. 8, T. 35 S., R. 1 W., W.M.;
thence North 20 rods; thence East 40 rods; thence South 20 rods; thence West
40 rods to the point of beginning.

16.3 acres in Lot 3 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$; SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$)

Section 8,

7.7 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$

15.0 acres in Lot 1 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$)

Section 9,

T. 35 S., R. 1 W., W.M.

This certificate also confirms a change in point of diversion approved by
an order of the State Engineer entered May 29, 1963 and recorded at page 462,
Volume 12, Special Order Record pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to
540.530.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
