By Supplemental Decree of the Circuit Court for Jackson County, Oregon, entered January 10, 1940, In the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Rogue River and Its Tributaries, a water right was established in the name of Henry Baker for the use of the waters of Sykes Creek for the irrigation of 12.6 acres in NE¼ SW¼, and 4.4 acres in SE¼ SW¼, Section 1, Township 35 South, Range 4 West, W.M., with a date of priority of 1908. These lands are irrigated through the Sykes Creek Ditch from a point of diversion located 3085 feet North and 375 feet West from the South ¼ corner of Section 1, being within the SE¼ NW¼ of Section 1, Township 35 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to irrigate these lands by means of pumps at the following points of diversion located: (1) 2430 feet North, 335 feet West from the South % corner of Section 1, being within the NE% SW% of Section 1; (2) 2165 feet North, 190 feet West from the South % corner of Section 1, being within the NE% SW% of Section 1; (3) 1880 feet North, 75 feet West from the South % corner of Section 1, being within the NE% SW% of Section 1; (4) 1555 feet North, 85 feet West from South % corner of Section 1. being within the NE% SW% of Section 1; (5) 1245 feet North, 90 feet West from South % corner of Section 1, being within the SE% SW% of Section 1; (6) 950 feet North, 120 feet West from South % corner of Section 1, being within the SE% SW% of Section 1, all being in Township 35 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

Notice of the filing of the application was given by publication setting forth a time and place certain for hearing objections to the proposed change in point of diversion of water, if any there were, namely: at the county courthouse in Medford, Oregon, on May 31, 1972, at 9:30 a.m. The notice was published in the <u>Medford Mail Tribune</u>, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Jackson County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of April 6, 13 and 20, 1972. The date set for hearing in said notice was not less than thirty days after the last publication of the notice.

Mr. David Hendrix, Watermaster of District No. 13, has filed a report to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in point of diversion of water from Sykes Creek, to-wit:

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices.

That the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to Henry Baker and recorded at page 32804, Volume 24, State Record of Water Right Certificates is canceled and upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the State Engineer of completion of the authorized change in point of diversion, a certificate of water right shall be issued to Francis J. Poole confirming the change in point of diversion.
