





On March 9, 1973, Raymond P. and Alyce B. Criss filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from Rogue River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

Certificate of water right issued to Soren M. Christensen, Wayne J. Bateman, Mart A. Williams and is recorded at page 39234, Volume 31, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of not to exceed 0.17 cubic foot per second of water from Rogue River for the irrigation of, among other lands, 0.42 acre in SEX SEX, Section 17, Township 36 South, Range 3 West, W.M., with a date of priority of March 16, 1928. These lands are irrigated from a point of diversion located North 58° East, 550 feet from the SW corner of Section 16, being within the SWX SWX, Section 16, Township 36 South, Range 3 West, W.M.

The applicants herein, owners of the lands above described, propose to irrigate these lands from a point of diversion to be located 740 feet North and 770 feet West from the SE corner of Section 17, being within the SE% SE%, Section 17, Township 36 South, Range 3 West, W.M.

Notice of the filing of the application was given by publication setting forth a time and place certain for hearing objections to the proposed change in point of diversion of water, if any there were, namely: at the county courthouse in Medford, Oregon, on May 22, 1973 at 9:30 a.m. The notice was published in the Daily Tidings, a

newspaper printed and having general circulation in Jackson County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of March 27, April 3 and 10, 1973. The date set for hearing in said notice was not less than thirty days after the last publication of the notice.

Mr. David C. Hendrix, Watermaster of District No. 13, has filed a report to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion of water may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is DRDERED that the change in point of diversion of water from Rogue River, to-wit:

From a point located North 58° East 550 feet from the SW corner of Section 16, being within the SW% SW% of Section 16, Township 36 South, Range 3 West, W.M.

To a point to be located 740 feet North and 770 feet West from the SE corner of Section 17, being within the SE% SE% of Section 17, Township 36 South, Range 3 West, W.M.

for the irrigation of 0.42 acre in the SE% SE%, Section 17, Township 36 South, Range 3 West, W.M., with a date of priority of March 16, 1928, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1973.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion, and shall not exceed 0.008 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices.

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificate of water right heretofore issued to Soren M. Christensen, Wayne J. Bateman, and Mart A.
Williams and recorded at page 39234, Volume 31, State Record of
Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new
certificate be issued covering the balance of the lands not involved
in this proceeding and upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the State
Engineer of completion of the authorized change in point of diversion,
a certificate of water right shall be issued to Raymond P. and Alyce B.
Criss confirming the change in point of diversion.
