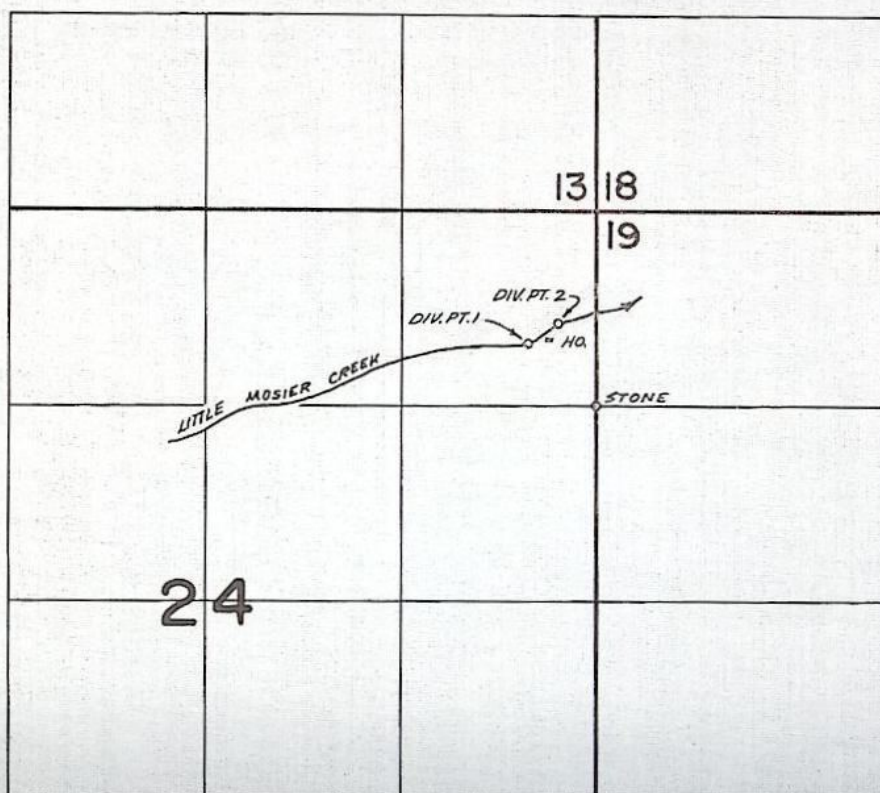

ORDER APPROVING  
TRANSFER NO. 2836

On June 18, 1973, L. G. Beck filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from Little Mosier Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

By Decree of the Circuit Court for Wasco County, Oregon, entered June 20, 1928, In the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Mosier Creek and its Tributaries, a water right was established in the name of William Terrill for the use of the waters of Little Mosier Creek for stock use and the irrigation of, among other lands, 3.0 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 24, Township 2 North, Range 11 East, W.M., with a date of priority of 1886, as evidenced by certificate of water right recorded at page 8159, Volume 8, State Record of Water Right Certificates. These lands are irrigated from a point of diversion located 1200 feet South and 1300 feet West from the Northeast corner of Section 24, being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 24, Township 2 North, Range 11 East, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to irrigate these lands from two points of diversion to be located 815 feet South and 450 feet West, and 740 feet South and 125 feet East from the Northeast corner of Section 24, being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 24, Township 2 North, Range 11 East, W.M.



ALL COTTON

Notice by publication as provided by ORS 540.520 was not given in connection with this application for the reason said section provides notice is not required on an application for a change in point of diversion of water of less than one-fourth mile where there are no intervening diversions.

Mr. Bill Porfily, Watermaster of District No. 3, has filed a report to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion of water may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the change in point of diversion of water from Little Mosier Creek, to wit:

From a point located 1200 feet South and 1300 feet East from the Northeast corner of Section 24, being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 24, Township 2 North, Range 11 East, W.M.

To a point to be located 815 feet South and 450 feet West from the Northeast corner of Section 24, being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 24, Township 2 North, Range 11 East, W.M.

And to a point to be located 740 feet South and 125 feet West from the Northeast corner of Section 24, being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 24, Township 2 North, Range 11 East, W.M.

for the irrigation of 3.0 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 24, Township 2 North, Range 11 East, W.M., with a date of priority of 1886, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1974.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices.

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificate of water right heretofore issued to William Terrill and recorded at page 8159, Volume 8, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the lands not involved in this proceeding and upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the State Engineer of completion of the authorized change in points of diversion, a certificate of water right shall be issued to L. G. Beck confirming the change in points of diversion.


