

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ROY H. & KATHRYN DATES

of Route 1. Box 107 Scio , State of Oregon 9737 has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Rilyeu and Bermeister Creeks a tributary of Thomas Creek, for the purpose of irrigation of 26.2 acres.

under Permit No. 20010 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 20, 1950,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.24 cubic foot per second, being 0.12 cubic foot per second from each stream.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE NW Section 17, Township 10 South, Range 1 East, W.K., 390' S & 740' W from the Nacor of Sec 17

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 2838

On June 25, 1973, Ron Bentz filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in place of use of water from Bilyeu Creek and Burmeister Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

Certificate of water right issued to Roy H. and Kathryn Bates and recorded at page 27143, Volume 19, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of not to exceed 0.24 cubic foot per second of water from Bilyeu Creek and Burmeister Creek for the irrigation of, among other lands, 16.4 acres in NE¹/₄ NW¹/₄, Section 17, Township 10 South, Range 1 East, W.M., with a date of priority of November 20, 1950. These lands are irrigated from a point of diversion located 300 feet South and 700 feet West from the N ½ corner of Section 17, being within the NE¹/₄ NW¹/₄, Section 17, Township 10 South, Range 1 East, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the land above described, proposes to transfer the water right therefrom, without loss of priority, to 16.4 acres in SE¹₄ SW¹₄, Section 8, Township 10 South, Range 1 East, W.M.

Notice by publication as provided by ORS 540.520 was not given in connection with this application for the reason that said section provides notice is not required on an application for a change in place of use of water.

Mr. Gene Mc Ginnis, Watermaster of District No. 2, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the change in place of use of water is approved and the water right hereinbefore described as appurtenant to 16.4 acres in NE¹/₄ NW¹/₄, Section 17, Township 10 South, Range 1 East, W.M., with a date of priority of November 20, 1950, be severed therefrom and simultaneously and without loss of priority transferred to 16.4 acres in SE¹/₄ SW¹/₄, Section 8, Township 10 South, Range 1 East, W.M.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1974.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificate of water right heretofore issued to Roy H. and Kathryn Bates and recorded at page 27143, Volume 19, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled and upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the State Engineer of application of water to beneficial use, a certificate of water right shall be issued to Ron Bentz confirming the extent to which the water has been applied beneficially and including the balance of the lands not involved in this proceeding.
