

On July 3, 1973, Harold E. Waller filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in place of use of water from Hamilton Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

Certificate of water right issued to William and Hester McPherson and recorded at page 26420, Volume 18, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of not to exceed 0.67 cubic foot per second of water from Hamilton Creek for the irrigation of, among other lands, 2.6 acres in SE¹/₄ NE¹/₄, and 17.0 acres in NE¹/₄ SE¹/₄, Section 21, Township 12 South, Range 1 West, W.M., with a date of priority of January 18, 1952. These lands are irrigated from a point of diversion located 1350 feet North and 275 feet East from the Southwest corner of Moore DIC #44, being within the SE¹/₄ NE¹/₄, Section 21, Township 12 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the land above described, proposes to transfer the water right therefrom, without loss of priority, to 9.8 acres in NE¹₂ NW¹₄, and 9.8 acres in SE¹₄ NW¹₄, Section 21, Township 12 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

Notice by publication as provided by ORS 540.520 was not given in connection with this application for the reason that said section provides notice is not required on an application for a change in place of use of water.

Mr. Gene Mc Ginnis, Watermaster of District No. 2, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights.

Gibraltar Onion Skin

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the change in place of use of water is approved and the water right hereinbefore described as appurtenant to 2.6 acres in SE¹/₄ NE¹/₄, and 17.0 acres in NE¹/₄ SE¹/₄, Section 21, Township 12 South, Range 1 West, W.M., with a date of priority of January 18, 1952, be severed therefrom and simultaneously and without loss of priority transferred to 9.8 acres in NE¹/₄ NW¹/₄, and 9.8 acres in SE¹/₄ NW¹/₄, Section 21, Township 12 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1974.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificate of water right heretofore issued to William and Hester McPherson and recorded at page 26420, Volume 18, State Record of Water Right Certificates is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the lands not involved in this proceeding, and upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the State Engineer of application of water to beneficial use, a certificate of water right shall be issued to Harold E. Waller confirming the extent to which the water has been applied beneficially.
