

On July 20, 1973, John and Yvonne A. Popp filed an application in the office of the Water Resources Director for approval of a change in point of diversion under an existing water right of record, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at Page 19511, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of William E. Strowbridge, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.018 cubic foot per second from Rogue River for irrigation of a certain 1.4 acres in NE4 SE4 of Section 16, Township 34 South, Range 1 West, W.M., with a date of priority of December 16, 1943.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 790 feet South and 360 feet West from the East quarter-corner of Section 16, being within the NE_4^1 SE_4^1 of Section 16, Township 34 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

The applicants herein, owners of the lands above described, propose to change the point of diversion and without loss of priority to irrigate said land from a point of diversion located 1090 feet South and 720 feet West from the East quarter-corner of Section 16, being within the NET SET of Section 16, Township 34 South, Range 1 West, W.M.
