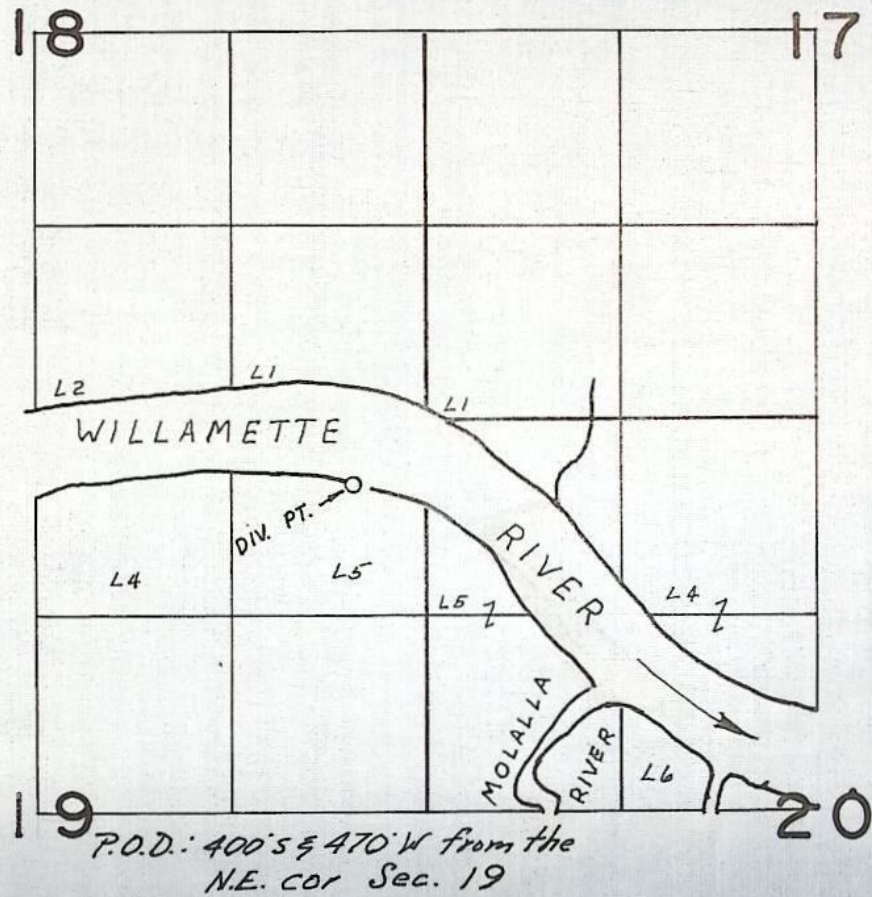

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.61 cubic foot per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **Lot 5 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ), Section 19, T. 3 S., R. 1 E., W. M.; 400 feet South and 470 feet West from the NE Corner, Section 19**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eightieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre** for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

ORDER APPROVING

On November 19, 1973, Pete N. Olson filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from Willamette River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

Certificate of water right issued to George F. and Leona Irene Weicker and recorded at page 29317, Volume 21, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of not to exceed 1.12 cubic feet per second of water from Willamette River for the irrigation of, among other lands, 9.5 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , 5.0 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , 35.4 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , 22.2 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , 24.4 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , and 22.8 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 19, Township 3 South, Range 1 East, W.M., with a date of priority of April 26, 1957. These lands are irrigated from a point of diversion located 450 feet South and 1100 feet West from the Northeast corner of Section 19, being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 19, Township 3 South, Range 1 East, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to irrigate these lands from a point of diversion to be located 400 feet South and 470 feet West from the Northeast corner of Section 19, being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 19, Township 3 South, Range 1 East, W.M.

Notice by publication as provided by ORS 540.520 was not given in connection with this application for the reason said Section provides notice is not required on an application for a change in point of diversion of water of less than one-fourth mile where there are no intervening diversions.



Mr. E. Michael Ricks, Watermaster of District No 16, has filed a report to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion of water may be made without injury to existing rights.

Deborah Drysdale and Harold Drysdale, contract sellers, have submitted written approval of the proposed change in point of diversion.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the change in point of diversion of water from Willamette River, to wit:

From a point located 450 feet South and 1100 feet West from the Northeast corner of Section 19, being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 19, Township 3 South, Range 1 East, W.M.

To a point to be located 400 feet South and 470 feet West from the Northeast corner of Section 19, being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 19, Township 3 South, Range 1 East, W.M.

for the irrigation of 9.5 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , 5.0 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , 35.4 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , 22.2 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , 24.4 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , and 22.8 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 19, Township 3 South, Range 1 East, W.M., with a date of priority of April 26, 1957, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1974.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion, and shall not exceed 1.01 cubic feet per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices.



That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificate of water right heretofore issued to George F. and Leona Irene Weicker and recorded at page 29317, Volume 21, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the lands not involved in this proceeding and upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the State Engineer of completion of the authorized change in point of diversion, a certificate of water right shall be issued to Pete N. Olson confirming the change in point of diversion.
