ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 2661

On May 31, 1972, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Humbolt Land & Livestock Company for approval of a change in place of use from Trout Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

By Decree of the Circuit Court for Harney County, dated February 23, 1916, in the matter of Edwin B. Hill, et al, vs. the American Land and Livestock Company, et al., a right was adjudicated to C. E. Thomas and L. W. Walter for use of water from the South Branch Trout Creek, under a date of priority of 1884, for irrigation of, among other lands, 20.0 acres in S½ SE½ NE½ and 30.0 acres in E3/4 NE½ SE½ of Section 36, Township 39 South, Range 35 East, W.M.

The authorized point of diversion is located 0 feet North and 0 feet West from the Southeast Corner of the SW4 NE4 of Section 31, Township 39 South, Range 36 East, W.M., being within the said SW4 NE4 of Section 31.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the place of use therefrom and, without loss of priority, to irrigate in lieu thereof a certain 10.0 acres in $E^{1/2}_{2}$ $NE^{1/4}_{3}$ $SW^{1/4}_{4}$ and 40.0 acres in $NW^{1/4}_{4}$ $SE^{1/4}_{3}$ of Section 31, Township 39 South, Range 36 East, W.M.

Mr. Walter N. Perry, Water Resources Department, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed

change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use of water from South Branch Trout Creek, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the diversion of water shall be limited to the water available from the South Branch of Trout Creek under the subject water right, pursuant to the provisions of said decree of the Court, with particular reference to paragraph 26 and to a subsequent paragraph which provides, in part, "A headgate shall always be maintained at the head of the South Branch ... at such times as the water is not needed for beneficial use for the purpose herein determined by any lower water users ... such amount may be allowed to flow through such headgate as may be necessary for the use of all appropriators or users there from ... ".

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the diversion of water shall be contingent upon maintaining an adequate system of drain ditches and controls to prevent the free-flooding of the lands from which the water right is hereby severed.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be carried out prior to the diverting of water as herein confirmed:

That the diversion works shall include a weir or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1979.
