



Notice of the filing of the application was given by publication setting forth a time and place certain for hearing objections to the proposed change in point of diversion of water, if any there were, namely: at the county courthouse in Prineville, Oregon, on January 16, 1973 at 9:30 a.m. The notice was published in The Central Oregonian, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Crock County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of November 23, 30, and December 7, 1972. The date set for hearing in said notice was not less than thirty days after the last publication of the notice.

Mr. Bruce A. Estes, Watermaster of District No. 11, has filed a report to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion of water may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the change in point of diversion of water from Crooked River, to-wit:

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be carried out prior to the diverting of water at the new point of diversion as herein confirmed.

That the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring

device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster

It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificate of water right heretofore issued to Otto C. Gray and recorded at page 7108, Volume 7, State<sup>th</sup>
Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and in lieu thereof a
new certificate of water right be issued covering the balance of the
lands not involved in this proceeding and upon receipt of proof satisfactory
to the State Engineer of completion of the authorized change in point of <sup>th</sup>
diversion, a certificate of water right shall be issued to Miller Tweedt
confirming the change in point of diversion.
