ORDER APPROVING
TRANSFER NO. 2800

On April 27, 1973, Juniper Broadcasting, Inc., by Gary L. Capps, President, filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in place of use of water from Deschutes River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

By Decree of the Circuit Court for Deschutes County, Oregon, entered September 30, 1958, In the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Deschutes River and its Tributaries, a water right was established in the name of Central Oregon Irrigation District for the use of the waters of Deschutes River for the irrigation of, among other lands, 3.0 acres in NW¼ NW¼, Section 27, and 2.0 acres in NE¼ NE¼, Section 28, Township 17 South, Range 12 East, W.M., being tabulated in the name of George Huettl, with dates of priority of October 31, 1900 and December 2, 1907, as evidenced by certificate of water right recorded at page 29052, Volume 21, State Record of Water Right Certificates. These lands are irrigated by means of the Central Oregon Canal.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to transfer the water right therefrom, without loss of priority, to 3.0 acres in NE¼ SW¼, Section 22, Township 17 South, Range 12 East, W.M., and 2.0 acres in S½ E½ N½ NE¼ SW¼, Section 28, Township 17 South, Range 13 East, W.M.

Notice by publication as provided by ORS 540.520 was not given in connection with this application for the reason that said section provides notice is not required on an application for a change in place of use of water.

The lands involved herein are within the boundaries of the Central Oregon Irrigation District and the Board of Directors of said District approved the proposed change in place of use of water at a regular meeting held February 7, 1973.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in place of use of water is approved and the water right hereinbefore described as appurtenant 3.0 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 27 and 2.0 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 28, Township 17 South, Range 12 East, W.M., with dates of priority of October 31, 1900 and December 2, 1907, be severed therefrom and simultaneously and without loss of priority transferred to 3.0 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 22, Township 17 South, Range 12 East, W.M., and 2.0 acres in S $\frac{1}{2}$ E $\frac{1}{2}$ N $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 28, Township 17 South, Range 13 East, W.M.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1974.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the State Engineer of complete application of water to beneficial use on the lands to which the water is transferred hereby, a certificate of water right will be issued to the Central Oregon Irrigation District confirming this and prior changes within the District.
