

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 2831

On June 11, 1973, George Pearson filed an application in the office of the Water Resources Department for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from Big Butte Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

Certificate of water right issued to Luke Ryan and recorded at Page 39597, Volume 31, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.056 cubic foot per second of water from Big Butte Creek for the irrigation of 4.5 acres in NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, Section 3, Township 34 South, Range 1 East, W.M., with a date of priority of April 15, 1913. These lands are irrigated by means of the Ryan ditch from a point of diversion located North 56 degrees 3 minutes West, 1170 feet from the Southeast corner of Section 3, being within the SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, Section 3, Township 34 South, Range 1 East, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to irrigate these lands from a point of diversion to be located 585 feet South and 800 feet West from the North quarter-corner of Section 3, being within the NE2 NW2, Section 3, Township 34 South, Range 1 East, W.M.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.510, was published in the Medford Mail-Tribune, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Jackson County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of August 22, 29 and September 5, 1973.

CHOLENICIA CAMOURONIA

Mr. David C. Hendrix, Watermaster of District No. 13, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

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No objection having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of diversion from Big Butte Creek, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion, and shall not exceed 0.056 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1977.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the portion of the right involved in the change authorized herein NOT be included in the new certificate to be issued as provided by the order entered October 12, 1976, approving transfer application No. 2816, and upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of the change in point of diversion authorized herein,
