



# CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That ROBERT R. DATISON

Trail Oregon State of , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Rogue River

a tributary of Irrigation

for the purpose of

under Permit No. of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 19, 1925;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.1 cubic foot per second.

The point of diversion is located in the NEINE of Section 5, Township 848, Range 18, W.M. The use hereunder for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

A description of the lands irrigated under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant (if for irrigation or any other purpose), is as follows: 1 acre in the NWANNT, Section 2, and 6.6 acres in the NEANET, Section 5, Township 34 South, Range 1 West, Willamette Meridian, in Jackson County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for any purpose is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

After the expiration of fifty years from the date of this certificate or on the expiration of any federal power license issued in connection with this right, and after not less than two years notice in writing to the holder hereof, the State of Oregon, or any municipality thereof, shall have the right to take over the dams, plants and other structures and all appurtenances thereto which have been constructed for the purpose of devoting to beneficial use the water rights specified herein, upon condition that before taking possession the State or municipality shall pay not to exceed the fair value of the property so taken, plus such reasonable damages, if any, to valuable, serviceable and dependable property of the holder of this certificate, not taken over, as may be caused by the severance therefrom of the property taken in accordance with the provisions of section 5728, Oregon Laws.

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 2669

On June 29, 1972, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Donald W. Wren for approval of a change in point of diversion from Rogue River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 9473, Volume 9, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Robert R. Dawson, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.012 cubic foot per second from Rogue River for irrigation of a certain 0.9 acre in NE¼ NE¾ of Section 3, Township 34 South, Range 1 West, W.M., with a date of priority of November 19, 1925.

The authorized point of diversion of record for said right is located 990 feet South and 285 feet West from the Northwest Corner of Section 3, being within the NE% NE% of Section 3, Township 34 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, is seeking approval of a change in point of diversion, without loss of priority, to an existing point of diversion located 1085 feet South and 915 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 3, being within the NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 3, Township 34 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.520(2), was published in the Medford Mail Tribune, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Jackson County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of October 3, 10, and 17, 1978.

Mr. David C. Hendrix, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of diversion, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1980.

The order of the Water Resources Director entered September 15, 1978, approving transfer application No. 3301, provided for cancellation of the certificate of water right recorded at page 9473, Volume 9, State Record of Water Right Certificates, and issuance of a new certificate covering the balance of the right NOT involved in the transfer proceedings; therefore,

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the portion of the right involved in the change authorized herein NOT be included in the new certificate to be issued as provided by the order entered September 15, 1978, approving transfer application No. 3301; and upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
