Certificate of water right issued to Thomas Owens and recorded at page 24773, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of not to exceed 0.29 cubic foot per second of water from Yamhill River for the irrigation of 0.4 acres in NE₄ SW₄, 8.8 acres in NW₄ SW₄ and 13.6 acres in SW₄ SW₄, Section 11, Township 4 South, Range 3 West, W.M., with a date of priority of June 3, 1954. These lands are irrigated from a point of diversion located 280 feet North and 1280 feet Nest from the SE corner of the NW₄ SW₄ of Section 11 being within the NW₄ SW₄ of Section 11, Township 4 South, Range 3 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to irrigate these lands from a point of diversion to be located North 13° West 730 feet from the SE corner of the NWL SWL of Section 11 being within the NWL SWL of Section 11, Township 4 South, Range 3 West, W.N.

Notice of the filing of the application was given by publication setting forth a time and place certain for hearing objections to the proposed change in point of diversion of water, if any there were, namely: at the county courthouse in McMinnville, Oregon, on December 4, 1972, at 9:30 a.m.

The notice was published in The Dayton Tribune, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Yamhill County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in

the issues of October 12, 19, and 26, 1972. The date set for hearing in said notice was not less than thirty days after the last publication of the notice.

Mr. Clayton J. Gardner, Watermaster of District No. 1, has filed a report to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1973.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion and shall not exceed 0.29 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER CRDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices.

That the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.
