

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 2699

On September 8, 1972, Arthur J. Donadei filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from West Fork Williams Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

entered April 26, 1919, In the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Rogue River and its Tributaries, a water right was established in the name of J. N. Larimore for the use of the waters of West Fork Williams Creek for the irrigation of, among other lands, 11.19 acres in SWA NWA, Section 8, Township 39 South, Range 5 West, W.M., with a date of priority of 1900, as evidenced by certificate of water right recorded at page 33247, Volume 25, State Record of Water Right Certificates. These lands are irrigated by means of the Pfaff-Ford ditch from a point of diversion located 75 feet North and 350 feet West from the East % corner of Section 7, being within the SE% NEW, Section 7, Township 39 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to irrigate these lands from a point of diversion to be located 735 feet North and 475 feet East from the East % corner of Section 7, being within the SW% NW%, Section 8, Township 39 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

Notice by publication as provided by ORS 540.520 was not given in connection with this application for the reason that said Section provides notice is not required on an application for a change in point of diversion of water of less than one-fourth mile where there are no intervening diversions.

Mr. Robert Steimer, Watermaster of District No. 14, has filed a report to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion of water may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the change in point of diversion of water from West Fork Williams Creek, to-wit:

From a point located 75 feet North and 350 feet West from the East % corner of Section 7, being within the SE% NE% of Section 7, Township 39 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

To a point to be located 735 feet North and 475 feet East from the East ¼ corner of Section 7, being within the SW% NW% of Section 8, Township 39 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

for the irrigation of 11.19 acres in SW% NW%, Section 8, Township 39 South, Range 5 West, W.M., with a date of priority of 1900, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1973.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion, and shall not exceed 0.186 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes

necessary to install headgates and measuring devices.

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That the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificate of water right heretofore issued to J. N. Larimore and recorded at page 33247, Volume 25,
State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and in lieu
thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the lands
not involved in this proceeding and upon receipt of proof satisfactory
to the State Engineer of completion of the authorized change in point
of diversion, a certificate of water right shall be issued to Arthur
J. Donadei confirming the change in point of diversion.
