

IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF JOHN J. KLASSEN FOR THE APPROVAL OF A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE OF WATER FROM NORTH FORK ASH CREEK

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 2700

On September 11, 1972, John J. Klassen filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in place of use of water from North Fork Ash Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

Certificate of water right issued to John J. Klassen and recorded at page 19614, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of 0.19 cubic foot per second of water from North Fork Ash Creek for the irrigation of 9.0 acres in SW_L^1 NE_L^1 and 6.0 acres in SE_L^1 NE_L^1 , Section 3, Township 8 South, Range 5 West, W.M., with a date of priority of December 10, 1943.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to transfer the water right therefrom, without loss of priority, to 11.8 acres in SW1 NE1 and 3.2 acres in SE1 NE1, Section 3, Township 8 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

Notice by publication as provided by ORS 540.520 was not given in connection with this application for the reason that said section provides notice is not required on an application for a change in place of use of water.

Mr. Gene McGinnis, Watermaster of District No. 2, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in place of use of water is approved and the water right hereinbefore described as appurtenant to 9.0 acres in SW1 NE1 and 6.0 acres in SE1 NE1, Section 3, Township 8 South, Range 5 West, W.M., with a date of priority of December 10, 1943, be severed therefrom and simultaneously and without loss of priority, transferred to 11.8 acres in SW1 NE1 and 3.2 acres in SE1 NE1, Section 3, Township 8 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1973.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificate of water right heretofore issued to John J. Klassen and recorded at page 19614, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled and upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the State Engineer of application of water to beneficial use, a certificate of water right shall be issued to John J. Klassen confirming the extent to which the water has been applied beneficially.
