CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That AUDREY Z. PARSONS, successor in interest to
C. E. Bellows,

of Eagle Point, State of Oregon, has a right
to the use of the waters of Rogue River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of
irrigation of 41.0 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 16, at page 523; that the priority of the right thereby
confirmed dates from 1892;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.03 cubic feet per
second.

The point of diversion is located in the Lot 3 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) Section 8, T. 35 S., R. 1 W., W.M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

2.0 acres in Lot 2 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 8,
described as follows:

Commencing at the SE corner of said Lot 2, Sec. 8, T. 35 S., R. 1 W., W.M.;
thence North 20 rods; thence East 40 rods; thence South 20 rods; thence West
40 rods to the point of beginning.

16.3 acres in Lot 3 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$; SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 8,

7.7 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
15.0 acres in Lot 1 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 9,
T. 35 S., R. 1 W., W.M.

This certificate also confirms a change in point of diversion approved by
an order of the State Engineer entered May 29, 1963 and recorded at page 462,
Volume 12, Special Order Record pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to
540.530.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.

ORDER APPROVING
TRANSFER NO. 2647

On May 19, 1972, Audrey Z. Parsons filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in point of diversion and place of use of water from Rogue River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

By Decree of the Circuit Court for Jackson County, Oregon, entered January 10, 1940, In the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Rogue River and its Tributaries, a water right was established in the name of Audrey Z. Parsons for the use of the waters of the Rogue River for the irrigation of, 2.0 acres in Lot 2 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$), 16.3 acres in Lot 3 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ & SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) Section 8, 7.7 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, and 15.0 acres in Lot 1 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 9, Township 35 South, Range 1 West, WM, with a date of priority of 1892. These lands are irrigated by a pumping plant located at a point of diversion 225 feet South and 730 feet West from the East $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Section 8, being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 8, Township 35 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the place of use of 0.3 acres in Lot 3 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 8, and 2.8 acres in Lot 1 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 9, to the irrigation of 3.1 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 9, Township 35 South, Range 1 West, W.M., and irrigate these lands together with the above lands from two points of diversion to be located (#1) 380 feet South and 880 feet West from the East $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Section 8, being within

the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 8, and (#2) located 2620 feet South and 440 feet East from the East $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Section 8, being within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 9, Township 35 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

Notice of the filing of the application was given by publication setting forth a time and place certain for hearing objections to the proposed change in place of use and point of diversion of water, if any there were, namely: at the county courthouse in Medford, Oregon, on August 30, 1972, at 9:30 a.m. The notice was published in the Medford Mail Tribune, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Jackson County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of July 5, 12 and 19, 1972. The date set for hearing in said notice was not less than thirty days after the last publication of the notice.

Mr. David C. Hendrix, Watermaster of District No. 13, has filed a report to the effect that the proposed change in place of use and point of diversion of water may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use and point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the change in place of use of water is approved and the water right hereinbefore described as appurtenant to 0.3 acre in Lot 3 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) Section 8, and 2.8 acres in Lot 1 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 9, Township 35 South, Range 1 West, W.M., be severed therefrom and simultaneously and without loss of priority transferred to 3.1 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 9, Township 35 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the proposed change in point of diversion of water from Rogue River, to-wit:

From a point located 225 feet South and 730 feet West from the East $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Section 8, being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 8, Township 35 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

To a point of diversion to be located 380 feet South and 880 feet West from the East $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Section 8, being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 8, Township 35 South, Range 1 West, W.M., and,

To a point of diversion to be located 2620 feet South and 440 feet East from the East $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Section 8, being within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 9, Township 35 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

for the irrigation of 2.0 acres in Lot 2 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$), 16.0 acres in Lot 3 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$) Section 8, 7.7 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, 15.3 acres in Lot 1 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$) Section 9, Township 35 South, Range 1 West, W.M., with a date of priority of 1892, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use and the change in point of diversion made on or before October 1, 1973.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water that is available at the old point of diversion and shall be limited to 1.03 cubic feet per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices.

That the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificate of water right heretofore issued to Audrey Z. Parsons is canceled and upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the State Engineer of the authorized change in

point of diversion and complete application of water to beneficial use on the lands to which the water is transferred hereby, certificate of water right shall be issued to Audrey Z. Parsons confirming the change in point of diversion and the extent to which the water has been applied beneficially.
