

## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

Selma Oregon , State of , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Clear Creek

Illinois River a tributary of irrigation of 12.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 10869 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 27, 1933 for 0.152 second-foot and June 8, 1933 for 0.088 second-foot

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.24 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SEt SWt, Section 2, T. 38 S., R. 8 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-fiftieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated throughout the irrigation season from April 1, to November 1 of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> 12.0 acres SEt NWt Section 11 T. 38 S., R. 8 W., W. M.

Certificate of water right issued to R. L. Hammer & Co. by R. L. Hammer, Jr. and recorded at page 12241, Volume 11, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms the right to the use of water for irrigation of 15.0 acres. A change in the right to the use of water appurtenant to 3.0 acres was approved by orders of the State Engineer entered December 13, 1972 and December 18, 1972. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right to the use of water for irrigation and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to R. L. Hammer & Co. by R. L. Hammer, Jr.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

a tributary of Illinois River irrigation of 1.0 acre

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 10869 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 27, 1933 for 0.013 c.f.s. and June 8, 1933 for 0.007 c.f.s.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion; SE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, Section 2, T. 38 S., R. 8 W., W. M., 230 feet North and 650 feet West from the N<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Corner, Section 11

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE¼ NW¼, Section 11, T. 38 S., R. 8 W., W. M., 1420 feet North and 1240 feet West from the Center, Section 11.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fiftieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated throughout the irrigation season from April 1, to November 1 of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> 1.0 acre NE¼ NW¼ Section 11 T. 38 S., R. 8 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered December 18, 1972 and together with certificates of water right recorded at Page 48253, Volume 41 and Page 39239, Volume 31, State Record of Water Right Certificates supersedes certificate of water right recorded at Page 12241, Volume 11, State Record of Water Right Certificates. The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.

IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF WARREN S. MORSE AND VIRGINIA B. MORSE FOR THE APPROVAL OF A CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION OF WATER FROM CLEAR CREEK

DRDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 2631

On July 31, 1972, Warren S. Morse and Virginia B. Morse filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from Clear Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

Certificate of water right issued to R. L. Hammer & Company, and R. L. Hammer, Jr. and recorded at page 12241, Volume 11, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of not to exceed 0.19 cubic foot per second with a date of priority of April 27, 1933, and 0.11 cubic foot per second with a date of priority of June 8, 1933, from Clear Creek, for the irrigation of, among other lands, 1.0 acre in NEM NUM, Section 11, Township 38 South, Range 8 West, W.M. These lands are irrigated from a point of diversion located 230 feet North and 650 feet West from the North % corner of Section 11, being within the SEM SUM of Section 2, Township 38 South, Range 8 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to divert the water for irrigation through a pump from a point located 1385 feet North and 1245 feet West from the center of Section 11, being within the NE% NW% of Section 11, Township 38 South, Range 8 West, W.M.

Notice of the filing of the application was given by publication setting forth a time and place certain for hearing objections to the proposed change in point of diversion of water, if any there were,

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namely: at the county courthouse in Grants Pass, Oregon, on November 14, 1972, at 9:30 a.m. The notice was published in the <u>Illinois Valley News</u>, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Josephine County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of September 21, 28, and October 5, 1972. The date set for hearing in said notice was not less than thirty days after the last publication of the notice.

Mr. Robert Steimer, Watermaster of District No. 14, has filed a report to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in point of diversion of water from Clear Creek, to-wit:

From a point located 230 feet North and 650 feet West from the North ¼ corner of Section 11, being within the SE¼ SW¼ of Section 2, Township 38 South, Range 8 West, W.M.

To a point to be located 1385 feet North and 1245 feet west from the center corner of Section 11, being within the NEM NUM of Section 11, Township 38 South, Range 8 West, W.M.

for the irrigation of 1.0 acre in NE% NW%, Section 11, Township 38 South, Range 8 West, W.M., with dates of priority of April 27, 1933 and June 8, 1933, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1973.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion, and shall not exceed 0.013 cubic foot per second with a date of priority of April 27, 1935 and 0.007 cubic foot per second with a date of priority of June 8, 1933.

It is FURTHER DRDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices.

That the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

The Order of the State Engineer entered December 13, 1972, approved an application of R. L. Hammer for a change in point of diversion for the irrigation of 2.0 acres, and canceled the certificate recorded at page 12241, Volume 11, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that on receipt of proof satisfactory to the State Engineer of completion of the authorized change in point of diversion, a certificate of water right shall be issued to Warren S. and Virginia B. Morse confirming said change in point of diversion. Dated at Salem, Dregon, this 18th day of December, 1972.

Notice is given hereby that Warren S. Morse and Virginia B. Morse have filed an application for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from Clear Creek.

Certificate of water right issued by R. L. Hammer & Co., by R. L. Hammer, Jr., and recorded at page 12241, Volume 11, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of 0.30 cubic foot per second from Clear Creek for the irrigation of, among other lands, 1.0 acres in NE¼ NW¼, Section 11, Township 38 South, Range 8 West, W.M., with date of prior-ity of 1933. Water for this use is diverted from a point located 230 feet North and 650 feet West from the North 1/4 corner of Section 11, being within the SE¼ SW¼, Section 2, Township 38 South, Range 8 West, W.M. The applicant herein, owner of the land above described, proposes to irrigate these lands from a point of diversion to be located 1385 feet North and 1245 feet West from the center of Section 11, being within the NE¼ NW¼ of Section 11, Township 38 South, Range 8 West, W.M.

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All persons interested are notified hereby that a hearing will be held at the county courthouse at Grants Pass, Oregon, on November 14, 1972, at 9:30 a.m. All objections to the proposed change if any there are, will be heard at said time and place. Any and all objections shall be prepared in writing, one copy to be served on Warren S. Morse and Virginia B. Morse, 18252 Redwood Highway, P. O. Box 762, Selma, Oregon. and one copy filed with the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon, together with a \$5 filing fee, at least 10 days prior to the date set for hearing. If no objections are filed, the application may be approved by the State Engineer without a hearing.
