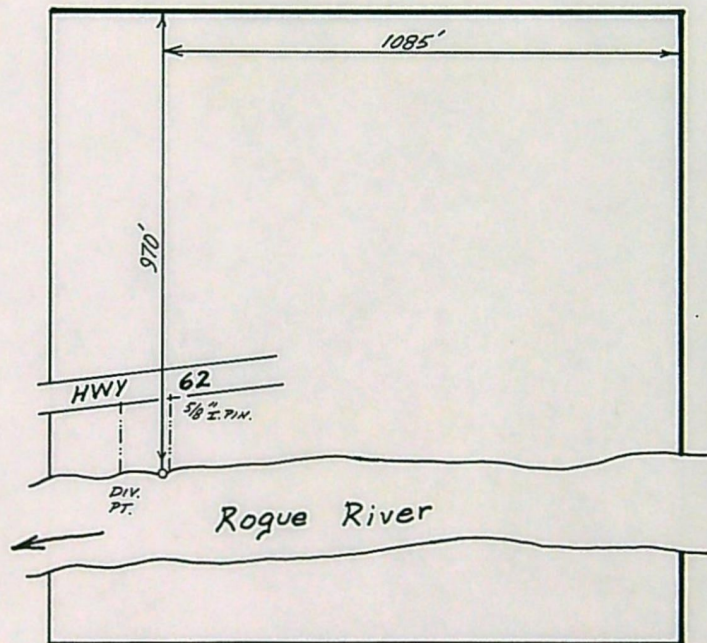

been constructed for the purpose of devoting to beneficial use the water rights specified herein, upon  
condition that before taking possession the State or municipality shall pay not to exceed the fair  
value of the property so taken, plus such reasonable damages, if any, to valuable, serviceable and  
dependable property of the holder of this certificate, not taken over, as may be caused by the  
severance therefrom of the property taken in accordance with the provisions of section 5728,  
Oregon Laws.

On April 19, 1972, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Roy T. Lannom for approval of a change in point of diversion from Rogue River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 9473, Volume 9, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Robert R. Dawson, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second from Rogue River for irrigation of 0.4 acre in NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 3, Township 34 South, Range 1 West, W.M., with a date of priority of November 19, 1925.

The authorized point of diversion of record for said right is located 990 feet South and 285 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 3, being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 3, Township 34 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the point of diversion therefrom, without loss of priority, to a point located 1080 feet South and 1025 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 3, being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 3, Township 34 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.520(2), was published in the Medford Mail Tribune, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Jackson County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of May 5, 12 and 19, 1972.

Mr. David C. Hendrix, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of diversion, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of



diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:


That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that NO time need be fixed for completion as the change in point of diversion is completed.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the portion of the right involved in the change authorized herein NOT be included in the new certificate to be issued as provided by the order entered September 15, 1978, approving transfer application No. 3301; and upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of the change in point of diversion authorized herein, a certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.

Notice is given hereby that Roy T. Lannom has filed an application for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from Rogue River.

Certificate of water right issued to Robert R. Dawson and recorded at page 9473, Volume 9, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of not to exceed 0.1 cubic foot per second of water from Rogue River, for irrigation of, among other lands, 0.50 acre in NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 3, Township 34 South, Range 1 West, W.M., with a date of priority of November 19, 1925.

The water is conveyed to these lands by means of a pump located at a point of diversion 990 feet South and 285 feet West from the NE corner of Section 3, being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 3, Township 34 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described proposes to irrigate these lands from a point of diversion to be located 1080 feet South and 1025 feet West from the NE corner of Section 3, being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 3, Township 34 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

All persons interested are notified hereby that a hearing will be held at the county courthouse at Medford, Oregon, on June 29, 1972, at 9:30 a.m. All objections to the proposed change, if any there are, will be heard at said time and place. Any and all objections shall be prepared in writing, one copy to be served on Roy T. Lannom, Star Route 1, Box 316, Trail, Oregon, and one copy filed with the State Engineer, Salem, Oregon, together with a \$5 filing fee, at least 10 days prior to the date set for hearing. If no objections are filed, the application may be approved by the State Engineer without a hearing. Administrative rules pertaining to the filing of a protest will be furnished by the State Engineer upon request.
