



ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 2638

On May 9, 1972, Leo J. and Marianne 0. van Dijk filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from Bear Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

By Decree of the Circuit Court for Jackson County, Oregon, entered April 29, 1925, In the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of the Rogue River and Its Tributaries, a water right was established in the name of Edward L. and Ruth G. Crain for the use of the waters of Bear Creek for the irrigation of 10.1 acres in NE¹/₄ SW¹/₄ and 1.9 acres in NW¹/₄ SW¹/₄, Section 32, Township 38 South, Range 1 East, W.M., with a date of priority of 1860. This right is evidenced by certificate recorded at page 37367, Volume 29, State Record of Water Right Certificates. These lands are irrigated by means of the Eagle Mill Ditch from a point of diversion located 805 feet North and 1185 feet East from the South quarter corner of Section 32 being within the SW¹/₄ SE¹/₄ of Section 32, Township 38 South, Range 1 East, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to irrigate said lands from a point of diversion to be located 1300 feet North and 210 feet West from the SE corner of DLC 48 being within the NEL SWL of Section 32, Township 38 South, Range 1 East, W.M.

Notice of the filing of the application was given by publication setting forth a time and place certain for hearing objections to the proposed change in point of diversion of water, if any there were, namely: at the county courthouse at Medford, Oregon, on September 5, 1972, at 9:30 a.m. The

notice was published in the Ashland Daily Tidings, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Jackson County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of July 12, 19, and 26, 1972. The date set for hearing in said notice was not less than thirty days after the last publication of the notice.

Mr. David C. Hendrix, Watermaster of District No. 13, has filed a report to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion of water may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion of water may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the change in point of diversion of water from Bear Creek, to-wit:

From a point located 805 feet North and 1185 feet East from the South quarter corner of Section 32 being within the SW_L^1 SE_L^1 of Section 32, Township 38 South, Range 1 East, W.M.

To a point to be located 1300 feet North and 210 feet West from the SE corner of DLC 48 being within the NE_{4}^{1} SW of Section 32, Township 38 South, Range 1 East, W.M.

for the irrigation of 10.1 acres in NEL SWL and 1.9 acres in NWL SWL, Section 32, Township 38 South, Range 1 East, W.M., with a date of priority of 1860, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1974.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion and shall not exceed 0.15 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices.

That the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificate of water right heretofore issued to Edward L. and Ruth G. Crain and recorded at page 37367, Volume 29, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled and upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the State Engineer of completion of the authorized change in point of diversion, a certificate of water right shall be issued to Leo J. and Marianne O. van Dijk confirming said change in point of diversion.
