

On March 26, 1974, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Ingram Brothers for approval of a change in point of diversion of water from Simpson Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

Pursuant to the provisions of ORS 537.260(2), proof has been made to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director that a right has been perfected under the terms of Permit 34520 in the name of Ingram Brothers, for the use of not to exceed 0.45 cubic feet per second from Simpson Creek, for irrigation, frost control and cranberry harvesting of 5.2 acres in NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 20, Township 28 South, Range 14 West, WM, with a date of priority of July 9, 1969.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 2,100 feet South and 250 feet West from the North Quarter Corner of Section 20, being within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 20, Township 28 South, Range 14 West, WM.

The applicants herein propose to change the point of diversion therefrom, without loss of priority, to a point located 100 feet North and 450 feet East from the Center of Section 20, being within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 20, Township 28 South, Range 14 West, WM.

Prior to the filing of the application for a change in point of diversion, Paul R. Kent and Rosetta A. Kent filed a protest against issuance of a Certificate of Water Right to Floyd Ingram and Kenneth Ingram confirming Permit R-5496. Said protest, filed November 1, 1973, alleged that part of the reservoir (Reservoir 1) cited by Permit R-5496 was situated on lands owned by the protestants. Permit 34520 allowed the diversion of water from Simpson Creek to be stored in said reservoir.

Subsequent to the filing of the protest, a barrier was constructed across the reservoir to divide the stored waters which were the basis of contention.

Subsequent to that, both parties sold their respective properties. Repeated correspondence to protestants attorney failed to elicit a response.

It appearing that there is no longer any basis for continuing the protest, the protest should be dismissed.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that said protest filed November 1, 1973, by Paul R. Kent and Rosetta A. Kent is dismissed.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of diversion, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that NO time need be fixed for completion as the change in point of diversion is completed.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding; and a confirming certificate of water right be issued to the applicants herein.
