

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3010

On April 3, 1974, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Jack Caldwell for approval of a change in point of diversion from Little Butte Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 26933, Volume 19, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Frank B. Hopewell, describes a right for the use of not to exceed 0.27 cubic foot per second from Little Butte Creek for irrigation of 10.9 acres in SW4 NE4 and 10.7 acres in NW4 SE4 of Section 8, Township 36 South, Range 1 West, W.M., with a date of priority of September 7, 1954.

The authorized point of diversion of record is located 1190 feet South and 380 feet West from the North Quarter Corner of Section 8, being within the NE¹/₄ NW¹/₄ of Section 8, Township 36 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the point of diversion therefrom, without loss of priority, to a point located 490 feet South and 500 feet East from the North Quarter Corner of Section 8, being within the NW4 NE4 of Section 8, Township 36 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.520(2), was published in the Medford Mail Tribune, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Jackson County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of October 9, 16 and 23, 1978.

Mr. David C. Hendrix, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of diversion, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1980.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right recorded at page 26933, Volume 19, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FRANK B. HOPEWELL

of Loute 1. Box 305. Eagle Point , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Little Butte Creek a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of irrigation of 21.6 acres,

under Permit No. 23271 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 7, 1954,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.27 cubic foot per second.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE¹/₄ NW¹/₄ as projected within Stow DLC #51. Section 8, Township 36 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $4\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be further limited to the terms and conditions of stipulation recorded on pages 901 and 902, Volume 3, Miscellaneous Records of the State Engineer and by reference made a part hereof,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> -10.9 acres SW1 NE1 5.7 acres NW1 SE1 5.7 acres NW1 SE1 Both as projected within Stow DLC #51 5.0 acres Lot 5 (NW1 SE1) Section 8 Township 36 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
