

of Route 2, Box 53, Silverton , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Silver Creek

a tributary of Pudding River irrigation of 40.0 acres for the purpose of

under Permit No. 27374 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 5, 1961,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.50 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE! ET; as projected within Cox DIC 45, Section 33, T. 6 S., R. 1 W., W. M., 440'S from the NE CorSCox DLC 45

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> 14.4 acres NN 4 NE4 19.4 acres SN NE4 1.9 acres NE4 NN 4.3 acres SE4 NN all as projected within Cox DLC 43 Section 33 T. 6 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use and point of diversion approved by an order of the WRD entered <u>June 25, 1974</u> and supersedes certificate of water right recorded on page <u>31805</u>, Volume <u>23</u>, SRWRC. The right to the use of the water for the purposes uppresses is restricted to the uses of place of use herein described.

ORDER APPROVING

TRANSFER NO. 3021

IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF LEROY E. BEALS FOR THE APPROVAL OF A CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION OF WATER FROM SILVER CREEK

On April 18, 1974, LeRoy E. Beals filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from Silver Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

Certificate of water right issued to Merle Bowen and recorded at page 31805, Volume 23, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of not to exceed 0.50 cubic foot per second of water from Silver Creek for the irrigation of 14.4 acres in NW_2^1 NE₂, 19.4 acres in SW_2^1 NE₂, 1.9 acres in NE₂ NW₂ and 4.3 acres in SE_2^1 NW₂, Section 33, Township 6 South, Range 1 West, W.M., with a date of priority of May 5, 1961. These lands are irrigated from a point of diversion located 620 feet South and 1780 feet West from the Northeast corner of S. Cox DLC #45, being within the NE₂ SW₂, Section 33, Township 6 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to irrigate these lands from a point of diversion to be located 338 feet South from the Northeast corner of S. Cox DLC #45, being within the SW1 NE1, Section 33, Township 6 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

Notice of the filing of the application was given by publication setting forth a time and place certain for hearing objections to the proposed change in point of diversion of water, if any there were, namely: at the county courthouse in Salem, Oregon, on June 18, 1974, at 9:30 a.m. The notice was published in the Oregon Statesman, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Marion County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of April 25, May 2 and 9, 1974. The date set for hearing in said notice was not less than thirty days after the last publication of the notice. Mr. E. Michael Ricks, Watermaster of District No. 16, has filed a report to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion of water may be made without injury to existing rights.

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No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the change in point of diversion of water from Silver Creek, to wit:

> From a point located 620 feet South and 1780 feet West from the Northeast corner of S. Cox DIC #45, being within the NEL SW1 of Section 33, Township 6 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

To a point to be located 338 feet South from the Northeast corner of S. Cox DIC #45, being within the SW2 NE2 of Section 33, Township 6 South, Range 1 West, W.M.

for the irrigation of 14.4 acres in NW2 NE2, 19.4 acres in SW2 NE2, 1.9 acres in NE' NW1, and 4.3 acres in SE1 NW2, Section 33, Township 6 South, Range 1 West, W.M., with a date of priority of May 5, 1961, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1975.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion, and shall not exceed 0.50 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices.

> That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.

> That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster. Bran Stat


