

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3025

On May 2, 1974, John R. Pattee filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in point of diversion and place of use of water from Applegate River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

By Decree of the Circuit Court for Jackson County, Oregon, entered May 19, 1964, In the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Rogue River and Its Tributaries, a water right was established in the name of W. W. Woodward for the use of the waters of Applegate River for the irrigation of 8.0 acres in the SW SE 1, Section 30, Township 36 South, Range 6 West, W.M., with a date of priority of February, 1898. These lands are irrigated from a point of diversion located 980 feet South and 200 feet West from the North 1 corner of Section 31, being within the NE 1 W 1, Section 31, Township 36 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to transfer the water right from the 8.0 acres in the SWA SEA, Section 30, Township 36 South, Range 6 West, W.M., without loss of priority to 1.0 acre in the SEA SWA and 7.0 acres in the SWA SEA, Section 30, Township 36 South, Range 6 West, W.M., and to irrigate these lands from a point of diversion to be located 180 feet South and 225 feet East from the North 1 corner of Section 31, being within the NWA NEA, Section 31, Township 36 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

Notice of the filing of the application was given by publication setting forth a time and place certain for hearing objections to the proposed

change in place of use and point of diversion of water, if any there were, namely: at the county courthouse in Grants Pass on December 10, 1974 at 9:30 a.m. The notice was published in the Grants Pass Daily Courier, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Josephine County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of October 15, 22 and 29, 1974. The date set for hearing in said notice was not less than thirty days after the last publication of the notice.

ALL COLUMN

Mr. Robert B. Steimer, Watermaster, District No. 14, has filed a report to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion and place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion and place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the change in place of use of water is approved and the water right hereinbefore described as appurtenant to 8.0 acres in the SW2 SE2, Section 30, Township 36 South, Range 6 West, W.M., with a date of priority of February, 1898, be severed therefrom and simultaneously and without loss of priority transferred to 1.0 acres in the SE2 SW2 and 7.0 acres in the SW2 SE2, Section 30, Township 36 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the proposed change in point of diversion of water from Applegate River, to wit:

From a point located 980 feet South and 200 feet West from the North & corner of Section 31, being within the NE% NW4, Section 31, Township 36 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

To a point to be located 180 feet South and 225 feet East from the North 2 corner of Section 31, being within the NW2 NE2, Section 31, Township 36 South, Range 6 West, W.M.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use and the change in point of diversion made on or before October 1, 1975.

ALLOWER

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion and shall be limited to 0.16 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices.

That the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificate of water right heretofore issued to W. W. Woodward and recorded at page 32924, Volume 24, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the State Engineer of completion of the suthorized change in place of use and point of diversion, a certificate of water right shall be issued to John R. Pattee confirming the extent to which water has been applied beneficially and the change in point of diversion.
