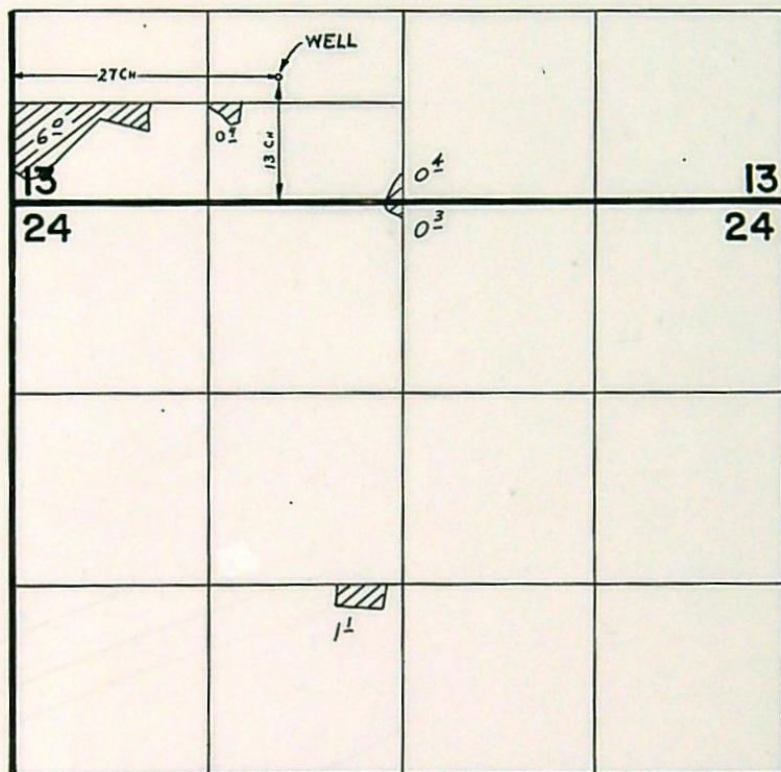

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JOHN L. GEYER

of 214 Sunny Drive, College Place, WA ⁹⁹³²⁴~~99328~~, State of Washington, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Geyer Well No. 5A

a tributary of Pine Creek, (~~Walla Walla River~~)
irrigation of 206.9 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. G-1897 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 20, 1961

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.59 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 13, T. 6 N., R. 33 E., W. M. Well located 13 chains North and 27 chains East from the SW corner, Section 13

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

ORDER APPROVING
TRANSFER NO. 3029

On May 7, 1974, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by John L. Geyer for a change in place of use under an existing water right of record, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 537.705.

The certificate recorded at page 32594, Volume 24, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of John L. Geyer, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.1 cubic foot per second from Geyer Well No. 5A for irrigation of 1.2 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, 4.0 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and 3.0 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 13, Township 6 North, Range 33 East, W.M., with a date of priority of June 20, 1961.

The well is located 13 chains North and 27 chains East from the Southwest corner of Section 13, being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 13.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the place of use therefrom, and without loss of priority to irrigate in lieu thereof a certain 6.0 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and 0.8 acre in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 13, 0.3 acre in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and 1.1 acre in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 24, Township 6 North, Range 33 East, W.M.

Mr. William I. Porfily, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1979.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order the certificate of water right heretofore issued to John L. Geyer and recorded at page 32594, Volume 24, State Record of Water Right Certificates, be canceled, and in lieu thereof a new confirming certificate of water right be issued to the applicant herein.
