The applicants herein, owners of the land above described, propose to transfer the water right therefrom, without loss of priority, to 8.0 acres in NW2 NE2, Section 12, Township 1 South, Range 3 West, W.M.

Notice by publication as provided by ORS 540.520 was not given in connection with this application for the reason that said section provides notice is not required on an application for a change in place of use of water.

Mr. Clayton J. Gardner, Watermaster of District No. 1, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights.

The Department of Veterans' Affairs, mortgagor of the property, has given approval of the change in place of use.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the change in place of use of water is approved and the water right hereinbefore described as appurtenant to 8.0 acres in NET NET, Section 11, Township 1 South, Range 3 West, W.M., with a date of priority of November 4, 1965, be severed therefrom and simultaneously and without loss of priority transferred to 8.0 acres in NWT NET, Section 12, Township 1 South, Range 3 West, W.M.

Duyck and recorded at page 38609, Volume 30, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Department of application of water to beneficial use, a certificate of water right shall be issued to Edmund H. Duyck confirming the extent to which the water has been applied beneficially.
