ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 2731

On November 8, 1972, Olav K. Lokken filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in place of use of water from an unnamed gulch, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

certificate of water right issued to Clav K. Lokken and recorded at page 31771, Volume 23, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of 0.01 cubic foot per second of water from an unnamed gulch for domestic and stock use in the SE¹₄ NW¹₄, Section 28, Township 35 South, Range 3 West, W.M., with a date of priority of December 21, 1959.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to transfer the water right therefrom, without loss of priority to the NW1 NW1, Section 28, Township 35 South, Range 3 West, W.M.

Notice by publication as provided by ORS 540.520 was not given in connection with this application for the reason that said section provides notice is not required on an application for a change in place of use of water.

Mr. David C. Hendrix, Watermaster of District No. 13, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in place of use of water is approved and the water right hereinbefore described

as appurtenant to the SEL NWL, Section 28, Township 35 South, Range 3 West, W.M., with a date of priority of December 21, 1959, be severed therefrom and simultaneously and without loss of priority, transferred to the NWL NWL, Section 28, Township 35 South, Range 3 West, W.M.

It is FURTHER CRDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1973.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificate of water right herefore issued to Olav K. Lokken and recorded at page 31771, Volume 23, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled and upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the State Engineer of application of water to beneficial use, a certificate of water right shall be issued to Olav K. Lokken confirming the extent to which the water has been applied beneficially.
