



By Decree of the Circuit Court for Josephine County, Oregon, entered May 19, 1964, In the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Rogue River and its Tributaries, a water right was established in the name of W. G. Records for the use of the waters of West Fork Williams Creek for the irrigation of 26.0 acres in North ½ NWX and SWX NWX, and 0.2 acre in SEX NWX, Section 3, Township 39 South, Range 5 West, W.M., with a date of priority of December 1908, as evidenced by certificate of water right recorded at page 32955, Volume 25, State Record of Water Right

Certificates.
