CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

LORETTA OWENS C/O H. A. BROUGHTON

of 14615 Water Gap Road, Williams , State of Oregon 97544 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Pleasant Creek

a tributary of Evans Creek irrigation of 20.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 9802 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 20, 1930

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.38 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion, SE_4 SE_4 , Section 33, T. 34 S., R. 4 W., W.M.; 780 feet North and 380 feet West from the SE Corner, Section 33

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW4 SW4, Section 34, T. 34 S., R. 4 W., W.M.; 1180 feet North and 200 feet East from the SW Corner, Section 34

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to One-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use and point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered April 24, 1973, and supersedes certificate of water right recorded at Page 9870, Volume 9, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

On August 11, 1972, Loretta Owens filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in point of diversion and place of use of water from Pleasant Creek, pursuant to the provisions of DRS 540.510 to 540.530.

Certificate of water right issued to Charles Owens and recorded at page 9870, Volume 9, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of not to exceed 0.38 cubic foot per second of water from Pleasant Creek for the irrigation of, 10.2 acres in SEM SEM, Section 33, D.8 acres in SWM, Section 34, Township 34 South, Range 4 West, W.M., and 9.0 acres in NEW NEW, Section 4, Township 35 South, Range 4 West, W.M., with a date of priority of August 20, 1930. These lands are irrigated from a point of diversion located 730 feet North and 380 feet West from the SE corner of Section 33, being within the SE% SE%, Section 33, Township 34 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described proposes to transfer the water right from 3.5 acres in SE% SE%, Section 33, Township 34 South, Range 4 West, W.M. and 1.0 acre in NE% NE%, Section 4, Township 35 South, Range 4 West, W.M., without loss of priority to 3.5 acres in SWM, Section 34, and 1.0 acres in SE% SE%, Section 33, Township 34 South, Range 4 West, W.M., and to irrigate these lands together with 6.7 acres in SE% SE%, Section 33, O.8 acre in SW%, Section 34, Township 34 South, Range 4 West, W.M., and 8.0 acres in NEW NEW, Section 4, Township 35 South,
Range 4 West, W.M., from a point of diversion to be located
1270 feet North and 200 feet East from the SW corner of Section 34,
being within the SWW SWW, Section 34, Township 34 South, Range 4
West, W.M.

Notice of the filing of the application was given by publication setting forth a time and place certain for hearing objections to the proposed change in point of diversion of water, if any there were, namely: at the county courthouse in Medford, Oregon, on January 31, 1973 at 9:30 a.m. The notice was published in the Medford Mail Tribune, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Jackson County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of December 7, 14 and 21, 1972. The date set for hearing in said notice was not less than thirty days after the last publication of the notice.

Mr. David C. Hendrix, Watermaster of District No. 13, has filed a report to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion of water may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the change in place of use of water is approved and the water right hereinbefore described as appurtenant to 3.5 acres in SE% SE%, Section 33, Township 34 South, Range 4 West, W.M., and 1.0 acre in NE% NE%, Section 4, Township 35 South, Range 4 West, W.M., with a date of priority of August 20, 1930, be severed therefrom and simultaneously and without loss of priority transferred to 3.5 acres in SWM SWM, Section 34, and 1.0 acres in SE% SE%, Section 33, Township 34 South,

Range 4 West, W.M.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the change in point of diversion of water from Pleasant Creek, to-wit:

From a point located 730 feet North and 380 feet West from the SE corner of Section 33, being within the SE% SE% of Section 33, Township 34 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

To a point to be located 1270 feet North and 200 feet East from the SW corner of Section 34, being within the SW% SW% of Section 34, Township 34 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

for the irrigation of 7.7 acres in SE% SE%, Section 33, 4.3 acres in SW% SW%, Section 34, Township 34 South, Range 4 West, W.M., and 8.0 acres in NE% NE%, Section 4, Township 35 South, Range 4 West, W.M., with a date of priority of August 20, 1930, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1973.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion, and shall not exceed 0.38 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices.

That the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER DRDERED that certificate of water right

heretofore issued to Charles Owens and recorded at page 9870,

Volume 9, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled,

and upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the State Engineer of

completion of the authorized change in point of diversion, a

certificate of water right shall be issued to Loretta Owens

confirming the extent to which the water has been applied beneficially

and the change in point of diversion.
