

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3126

On September 5, 1974, Albert Gurries filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in place of use of water from East Fork Illinois River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

By Decree of the Circuit Court for Josephine County, In the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Illinois River and Its Tributaries, a water right was established in the name of Benjamin George for the use of the waters of East Fork Illinois River for the irrigation of, among other lands, 4.6 acres in SW NE; West of the Kirby Ditch, Section 16, Township 39 South, Range 8 West, W.M., with a date of priority of May, 1887. This right is evidenced by certificate recorded at page 13861, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to transfer the water right therefrom, without loss of priority, to 4.6 acres in the SWL NEL, East of the Kirby Ditch, Section 16, Township 39 South, Range 8 West, W.M.

Notice by publication as provided by ORS 540.520 was not given in connection with this application for the reason that said section provides notice is not required on an application for a change in place of use of water.

Mr. Robert B. Steimer, Watermaster of District No. 14, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in place of use of water is approved and the water right hereinbefore described as appurtenant to 4.6 acres in the SW2 NE2, West of the Kirby Ditch, Section 16, Township 39 South, Range 8 West, W.M., with a date of priority of May, 1887, be severed therefrom and simultaneously and without loss of priority transferred to 4.6 acres in the SW2 NE2, East of the Kirby Ditch, Section 16, Township 39 South, Range 8 West, W.M.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1975.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificate of water right heretofore issued to Benjamin George and recorded at page 13861, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the lands not involved in this proceeding, and upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the State Engineer of application of water to beneficial use, a certificate of water right shall be issued to Albert Gurries confirming the extent to which the water has been applied beneficially.
