

Notice of the filing of the application was given by publication setting forth a time and place certain for hearing objections to the proposed change in point of diversion of water, if any there were, namely: at the county courthouse in Fendleton, Oregon, on April 27, 1975 at 9:30 a.m., and at the county courthouse in Heppner, Oregon, on April 30, 1975, at 9:30 a.m. The notice was published in the Fendleton East Oregonian and the Heppner Gazette Times, newspapers printed and having general circulation in Umatilla and Morrow Counties, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of March 6, 13 and 20, 1975. The date set for hearing in said notice was not less than thirty days after the last publication of the notice.

Mr. William I. Porfily, Watermaster of District No. 5, has filed a report to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion of water may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificate of water right heretofore issued to Raymond Dunn and William McClannahan and recorded at page 36680, Volume 28, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled and upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the State Engineer of completion of the authorized change in point of diversion, a certificate of water right shall be issued to Oregon Potato, Inc., confirming the change in point of diversion.
