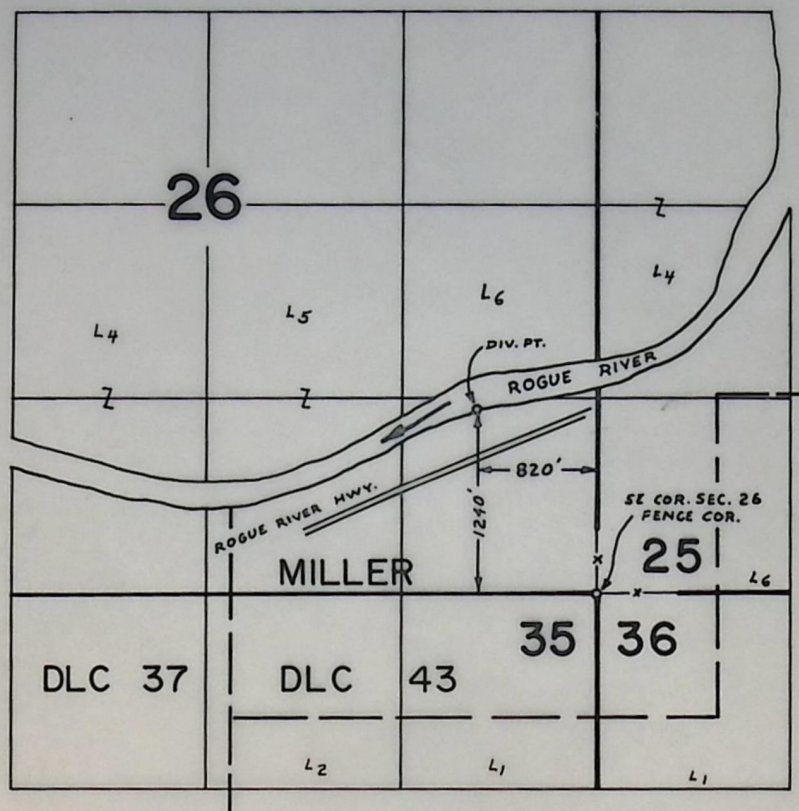

On February 12, 1975, Richard J. and Cecile M. Camden filed an application for transfer of water right in the office of the Water Resources Director proposing a change in point of diversion under an existing right of record to appropriate not to exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second of water from Rogue River, with a date of priority of October 16, 1916, at a point of diversion located north 38 degrees East, 4900 feet from the Southwest corner of Section 11, being within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 11, Township 36 South, Range 3 West, W.M., for the irrigation of 0.8 acre in SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 26, Township 36 South, Range 4 West, W.M., being a portion of the right evidenced by the certificate recorded at Page 10956, Volume 10, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to irrigate this land from a point of diversion to be located 1190 feet North and 780 feet West from the Southeast corner of Section 26, being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 26, Township 36 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.510, was published in the Medford Mail Tribune, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Jackson County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of June 14, 21 and 28, 1976.

Mr. David C. Hendrix, Watermaster of District No. 13, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.



No objection having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of diversion is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1977.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install head-gates and measuring devices.

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of the authorized change in point of diversion, a certificate of water right shall be issued to Richard J. and Cecile M. Camden confirming the change in point of diversion.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

After the expiration of fifty years from the date of this certificate or on the expiration of any federal power license issued in connection with this right, and after not less than two years' notice in writing to the holder hereof, the State of Oregon, or any municipality thereof, shall have the right to take over the dams, plants and other structures and all appurtenances thereto which have been constructed for the purpose of devoting to beneficial use the water rights specified herein, upon condition that before taking possession the State or municipality shall pay not to exceed the fair value of the property so taken, plus such reasonable damages, if any, to valuable, serviceable and dependable property of the holder of this certificate, not taken over, as may be caused by the severance therefrom of the property taken in accordance with the provisions of section 47-508, Oregon Code 1930.
