



ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3086

On July 9, 1974, Richard O. Rhoten filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from Evans Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

May 19, 1964, In the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Rogue River and its Tributaries, water rights were established in the names of William Waggoner and Ed E. Dimmick for the use of the waters of Evans Creek for stock and irrigation of, among other lands, 10.0 acres in the SE4 NW2 and 20.0 acres in the W2 SW2 NE4, Section 11, Township 35 South, Range 4 West, W.M., with a date of priority of 1896, as evidenced by certificates of water right recorded at Page 16118, Volume 13, and Page 32768, Volume 24, State Record of Water Right Certificates. These lands are irrigated by means of the Williams and Whalen ditch from a point of diversion located 475 feet North and 860 feet West from the Southeast corner of Section 6, being within the SE4 SE4, Section 6, Township 35 South, Range 3 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to irrigate these lands from a point of diversion to be located 410 feet South and 650 feet East from the center corner of Section 11, being within the NW4 SE4, Section 11, Township 35 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

Notice of the filing of the application was given by publication setting forth a time and place certain for hearing objections to the proposed change in point of diversion of water, if any there were, namely: at the

county courthouse in Medford, Oregon, on June 5, 1975, at 9:30 a.m. The notice was published in the Medford Mail Tribune, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Jackson County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of April 7, 14 and 21, 1975. The date set for hearing in said notice was not less than thirty days after the last publication of the notice.

Mr. David C. Hendrix, Watermaster of District No. 13, has filed a report to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion of water may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the dange in point of diversion of water from Evans Creek, to wit:

From a point located 475 feet North and 860 feet West from the Southeast corner of Section 6, being within the SE2 SE2 of Section 6, Township 35 South, Range 3 West, W.M.

To a point to be located 410 feet South and 650 feet East from the center corner of Section 11, being within the NW2 SE2 of Section 11, Township 35 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

for stock use and irrigation of 10.0 acres in SE2 NW2 and 20.0 acres in W2 SW2 NE2, Section 11, Township 35 South, Range 4 West, W.M., with a date of priority of 1896, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1976.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion, and shall not exceed 0.195 cubic foot per second under certificate No. 16118 and 0.33 cubic foot per second under certificate No. 32768, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

It is FURTHER CRIERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install head-gates and measuring devices.


That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificates of water right heretofore issued to William Waggoner and recorded at page 16118, Volume 13, and Ed E. Dimmick, recorded at page 32768, Volume 24, State Record of Water Right Certificates, are canceled, and in lieu thereof new certificates be issued covering the balance of the lands not involved in this proceeding and upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the State Engineer of completion of the authorized change in point of diversion, a certificate of water right shall be issued to Richard C. Rhoten confirming the change in point of diversion.

ORDER

On October 15, 1979, Rene L. and Mary A. Charlebois submitted an affidavit that they are the owners of certain water rights and the lands to which the water rights are appurtenant; that they have abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water rights and request the same be canceled.

The water rights in question were established by Decree of Circuit Court for Jackson County, entered April 26, 1919, in the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights of the Use of the Waters of Rogue River, tabulated in the name of Wm. W. Williams and William Waggoner, at Page 17, Volume 4, Order Record of the Water Resources Director, and are portions of the rights described by the certificates respectively recorded at Pages 16117 and 16118, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, and are for the use of not to exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second of water per each water right from Evans Creek, with dates of priority of 1896, for domestic use in the SE4 NW4 Section 11, Township 35 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

An administrative order of the Water Resources Director approving transfer application No. 2968 provides for cancellation of the certificates recorded at Page 16117 and 16118, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the said water rights, being a portion of the rights described by the prior certificates recorded at Pages 16117 and 16118, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, are canceled.
