

ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 9260 submitted by

VERSTEEG FAMILT, LLC P.O. BOX 2437 CAVE JUNCTION, OREGON 97523.

The right to be modified was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JOSEPHINE County as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 43598. The decree is recorded in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 13, at Page 70. The date of priority is MAY, 1887.

The right allows the use of EAST FORK ILLINOIS RIVER, a tributary of ILLINOIS RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 4.7 ACRES. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed ONE-FIFTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 1st to November 1st of each year, if available at the authorized point of diversion: SE% NW%, SECTION 27, T 39 S, R 8 W, W.M., or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2).

Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-080 and OAR 690-01-005 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

SW% SE%, SECTION 17, TOWNSHIP 39 SOUTH, RANGE 8 WEST, W.M.; 340 FEET NORTH AND 2595 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER SECTION 17.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 2005.
- The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion.
- 3. The water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an inline flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 4. Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source as the original point of diversion.

5. The water user shall install and maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device. The type and plans of the screen or by-pass device must be approved by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife prior to beginning of construction and shall be installed under the supervision of the Department of Fish and Wildlife.

The water user may participate in the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's cost sharing program for installation of screening and by-pass devices in accordance with ORS 540.525.

Certificate 43598 is canceled. A new certificate will be issued to describe that portion of the right NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.

On October 3, 1974, Edward Podoll and L. A. Cushing filed an application in the office of the Water Resources Director for the approval of a change in point of diversion and place of use of water from East Fork Illinois River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

Certificate of water right issued to A. G. Croy and recorded at page 13844, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of not to exceed 0.924 cubic foot per second of water from East Fork Illinois River for the irrigation of, among other lands, 6.6 acres in the NE¹/₄ NE¹/₄, 7.0 acres in the NW¹/₄ NE¹/₄, and 0.1 acre in the SE¹/₄ NE¹/₄, Section 20, Township 39 South, Range 8 West, W.M., with a date of priority of May, 1887.

Mr. Robert B. Steimer, Watermaster of District No. 14, has filed a report to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion and place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights.
