

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3623

On April 12, 1977, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Robert L. Adams for a change in point of diversion under an existing water right of record, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 32944, Volume 24, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of B. E. Holland, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.08 cubic foot per second from Williams Creek for irrigation of 4.0 acres in S¼ SW¼ NW¾ of Section 35, Township 38 South, Range 5 West, W.M., with a date of priority of January 14, 1904.

Water for the said right is diverted, through Dixon-Sparlin Ditch, from a point located 650 feet North and 200 feet East from the Southwest corner of Section 35, being within the SW4 SW4 of said Section 35.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the point of diversion therefrom, without loss of priority, to a point located 2300 feet North and 800 feet East from the Southwest corner of Section 35, being within the NW4 SW4 of said Section 35.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.510, was published in the Grants Pass Daily Courier, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Josephine County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of August 11, 18 and 25, 1977.

Mr. Robert B. Steimer, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objection having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of diversion from Williams Creek, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right, and shall not exceed 0.08 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install head-gates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1979.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to B. E. Holland and recorded at page 32944, Volume 24, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding, and upon proof

satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.

Holland, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.08 cubic foot per 'second from Williams Creek for irrigation of 4.0 acres in S¼ SW¼ NW1/4 of Section 35, Township 38 South, Range 5 West, WM, with a date of priority of January 14, 1904. Water for said right is diverted, through Dixon-Sparlin Ditch, from a point located 650 ft. N and 200 ft. E from the SW corner of Sec. 35, being within the SW1/4 SW1/4 of said Sec. 35.

Adams, 20365 Williams Hwy, Williams, OR 97544 and one copy filed with the Water Resources Department, Salem, OR 97310, together with a \$10 filing fee, at least 10 days prior to the date set for hearing. IF NO OBJECTIONS ARE FILED, THE APPLICATION MAY BE APPROVED BY THE WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR WITHOUT A HEAR-ING. Administrative rules pertaining to the filing of a protest will be furnished by the Water Resources Department upon request.
