CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FORREST SOLOMON

of 33662 East Park Drive, Creswell, State of OR 97426, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and Umpqua River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of domestic use for one family including the irrigation of lawn and garden not to exceed one-half acre in area and irrigation of 36.0 acres under Permit No. 34320 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 16, 1969

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.46 cubic foot per second; being 0.01 cfs for domestic use from stream and 0.45 cfs for irrigation from Umpqua River; if available from the origin Umpqua River point of diversion; SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 4, T22S, R8W, WM;*

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the River - SE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 4, Stream - NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 9, both as projected within Sawyer DLC 49, T22S, R8W, WM; River - 970 feet North and 1680 feet East; Stream - 220 feet South and 1900 feet East, both from SW corner Section 4.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eighth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

ORDER APPROVING
TRANSFER NO. 3630

On April 18, 1977, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Forrest Solomon for a change in point of diversion under an existing water right of record, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at Page 42626, Volume 34, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Forrest Solomon, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.45 cubic foot per second from Umpqua River for irrigation of 14.8 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, 17.7 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and 0.1 acre in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 4, and 3.4 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 5, Township 22 South, Range 8 West, W.M., with a date of priority of April 16, 1969.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 970 feet North and 1280 feet East from the Southwest corner of Section 4, being within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 4, Township 22 South, Range 8 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the point of diversion, without loss of priority, to a point located 970 feet North and 1680 feet East from the Southwest corner of Section 4, being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 4.

Mr. M. John Youngquist, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objection having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of diversion from Umpqua River, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right, and shall not exceed 0.45 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install head-gates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1978.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, the certificate of water right heretofore issued to Forrest Solomon and recorded at Page 42626, Volume 34, State Record of Water Right Certificates, be canceled, and in lieu thereof a new confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
