a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose domestic use for one family including the irrigation of lawn and garden not t exceed one-half acre in area and irrigation of 36.0 acres

under Permit No. 34320 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates fro April 16, 1969

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purpos aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not excee 0.46 cubic foot per second; being 0.01 cfs for domestic use from stream a 0.45 cfs for irrigation from Umpqua River; if available from the origin Umpqua River point of diversion; SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 4, T22S, R8W, WM;*

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3630

On April 18, 1977, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Forrest Solomon for a change in point of diversion under an existing water right of record, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at Page 42626, Volume 34, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Forrest Solomon, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.45 cubic foot per second from Umpqua River for irrigation of 14.8 acres in SW4 SW4, 17.7 acres in SE4 SW4 and 0.1 acre in SW4 SE4 of Section 4, and 3.4 acres in SE4 SE4 of Section 5, Township 22 South, Range 8 West, W.M., with a date of priority of April 16, 1969.

Water for the said right is diverted from a point located 970 feet North and 1280 feet East from the Southwest corner of Section 4, being within the SW_4^1 SW_4^1 of Section 4, Township 22 South, Range 8 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the point of diversion, without loss of priority, to a point located 970 feet North and 1680 feet East from the Southwest corner of Section 4, being within the SEA SWA of said Section 4.

Mr. M. John Youngquist, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objection having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of diversion from Umpqua River, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right, and shall not exceed 0.45 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install head-gates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1978.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water
Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the
extent intended under the provisions of this order, the certificate of water
right heretofore issued to Forrest Solomon and recorded at Page 42626, Volume 34,
State Record of Water Right Certificates, be canceled, and in lieu thereof a
new confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
