

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3687

On May 27, 1977, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Creston J. Shaw for approval of changes in place of use and point of diversion from Grande Ronde River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 29163, Volume 21, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of McAlister Ditch Company, describes a right which includes the use of water from Grande Ronde River for irrigation of a certain 32.5 acres in NE¹/₄ SW¹/₄ and 7.5 acres in NW¹/₄ SW¹/₄ of Section 12, Township 3 South, Range 38 East, W.M., with a date of priority of 1871.

Water for the said right is diverted, through the McAlister Ditch, from a point located 490 feet North and 640 feet East from the South Quarter Corner of Section 32, being within the SW4 SE4 of Section 32, Township 2 South, Range 38 East, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the place of use and point of diversion therefrom and, without loss of priority, to irrigate, in lieu thereof, 40.0 acres in NE¼ SE¼ of Section 8, Township 2 South, Range 39 East, W.M. from a point of diversion located 1310 feet South and 250 feet East from the Northwest Corner of Section 15, being within the NW¼ NW¼ of Section 15, Township 2 South, Range 39 East, W.M. (State Ditch).

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540. 510, was published in the Eastern Oregon Review, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Union County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of September 29, October 6 and 13, 1977.

Mr. Boyd Hadden, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed changes in place of use and point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed changes in place of use and point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested changes in place of use and point of diversion of water from Grande Ronde River, as described herein, without loss of priority, are approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made and said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1979.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to McAlister Ditch Company and recorded at page 29163, Volume 21, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding, and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
