ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3690

On May 31, 1977, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Jim Nartz for approval of a change in point of diversion from Trout Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 2234, Volume 3, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Mrs. C. Friend, describes a right which includes the use of water from Trout Creek for irrigation of 4.4 acres in SW4 NE4, 3.6 acres in SE4 NW4, 8.8 acres in NE4 SW4, 1.1 acres in SE4 SW4, 5.0 acres in NW4 SE4 and 0.1 acre in SW4 SE4 of Section 25, Township 9 South, Range 16 East, W.M., with a date of priority of 1891.

The authorized point of diversion is located 575 feet South and 200 feet East from the South Quarter Corner of Section 25, being within the NW4 NE4 of Section 36, Township 9 South, Range 16 East, W.M. (Friend Ditch No. 4).

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to Mrs. C. Friend and recorded at page 2234, Volume 3, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding, and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water shall be issued to the applicant herein.
