On July 25, 1975, Dorothy B. Sims filed an application in the office of the Water Resources Director for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from Crooked River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

Certificate of water right issued to Low Line Ditch Company and recorded at Page 36478, Volume 28, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of not to exceed 2.7 cubic feet per second of water from Crooked River for the irrigation of, among other lands, 7.1 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, 22.1 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and 5.0 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 28, Township 14 South, Range 14 East, W.M., with a date of priority of 1903. These lands are irrigated from a point of diversion located 1000 feet North and 1000 feet West from the Southeast corner of Section 24, being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 24, Township 14 South, Range 14 East, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to irrigate these lands from a point of diversion to be located 270 feet North and 190 feet West from the Northwest corner of Section 28, being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 20, Township 14 South, Range 14 East, W.M.

Notice of the filing of the application was given by publication setting forth a time and place certain for hearing objections to the proposed change in point of diversion of water, if any there were, namely: at the county courthouse in Prineville, Oregon, on April 27, 1976, at 9:30 a.m.

To a point to be located 270 feet North and 190 feet West from the Northwest corner of Section 28, being within the $SE\frac{1}{4}$ $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 20, Township 14 South, Range 14 East, W.M.

for the irrigation of 7.1 acres in $NE\frac{1}{4}$ $NW\frac{1}{4}$, 22.1 acres in $NW\frac{1}{4}$ $NW\frac{1}{4}$ and 5.0 acres in $SW\frac{1}{4}$ $NW\frac{1}{4}$, Section 28, Township 14 South, Range 14 East, W.M., with a priority date of 1903, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1977.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion, and shall not exceed 0.43 cubic foot per second.


It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install head-gates and measuring devices.

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to Low Line Ditch Company and recorded at Page 36478, Volume 28, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right not involved in this proceeding, and upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of the authorized change in point of diversion, a certificate of water right shall be issued to Dorothy B. Sims confirming the change in point of diversion.



On September 6, 1968, Cecil Teagarden filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in point of diversion and place of use of water from Crooked River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

I checked with the Crook County Assessor for taxlots owned by Jerry Rank and found:

141421	200
141428	200
141428	400
141429	100

I pasted together the tax lot maps and colored in the areas covered by water rights. I obtained these records from the local Watermaster's Office, and cross-checked them with the Water Resources Department's records in Salem. My results agree with Steve Applegate's report in almost all respects. The one exception is in the NE1/4 NW1/4 of section 28. Here I found less acres than Mr. Applegate did, due to changes in the taxlot boundary. I estimated that 22.5 acres of the primary right lie in taxlot 200, where Mr. Applegate had 27.9 acres.

In summary, the Jerry Rank properties have a total of 185.2 acres of primary right from Crooked River and 35.1 acres of supplemental rights from Prineville Reservoir through a contract with the Bureau of Reclamation.

The only significant area not covered by a water right is that area between the highway and the canal in taxlot 1414280000200, approximately 20 acres. I can find no record of a water right for these lands. Therefore, unless I am mistaken, there is simply no room to squeeze in more water rights than what we have already found.

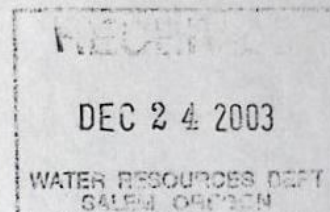
The priority dates of these rights are all "good" in the sense that they will have water available in all but the very worst droughts. Their value should be comparable to the rights of the Ochoco Irrigation District.

I enclose my summary listing, map, and Steve Applegate's report.

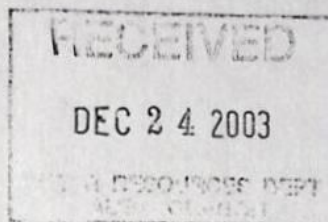

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to Low Line Ditch Company and recorded at Page 36478, Volume 28, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right not involved in this proceeding, and upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of the authorized change in point of diversion, a certificate of water right shall be issued to Dorothy B. Sims confirming the change in point of diversion.

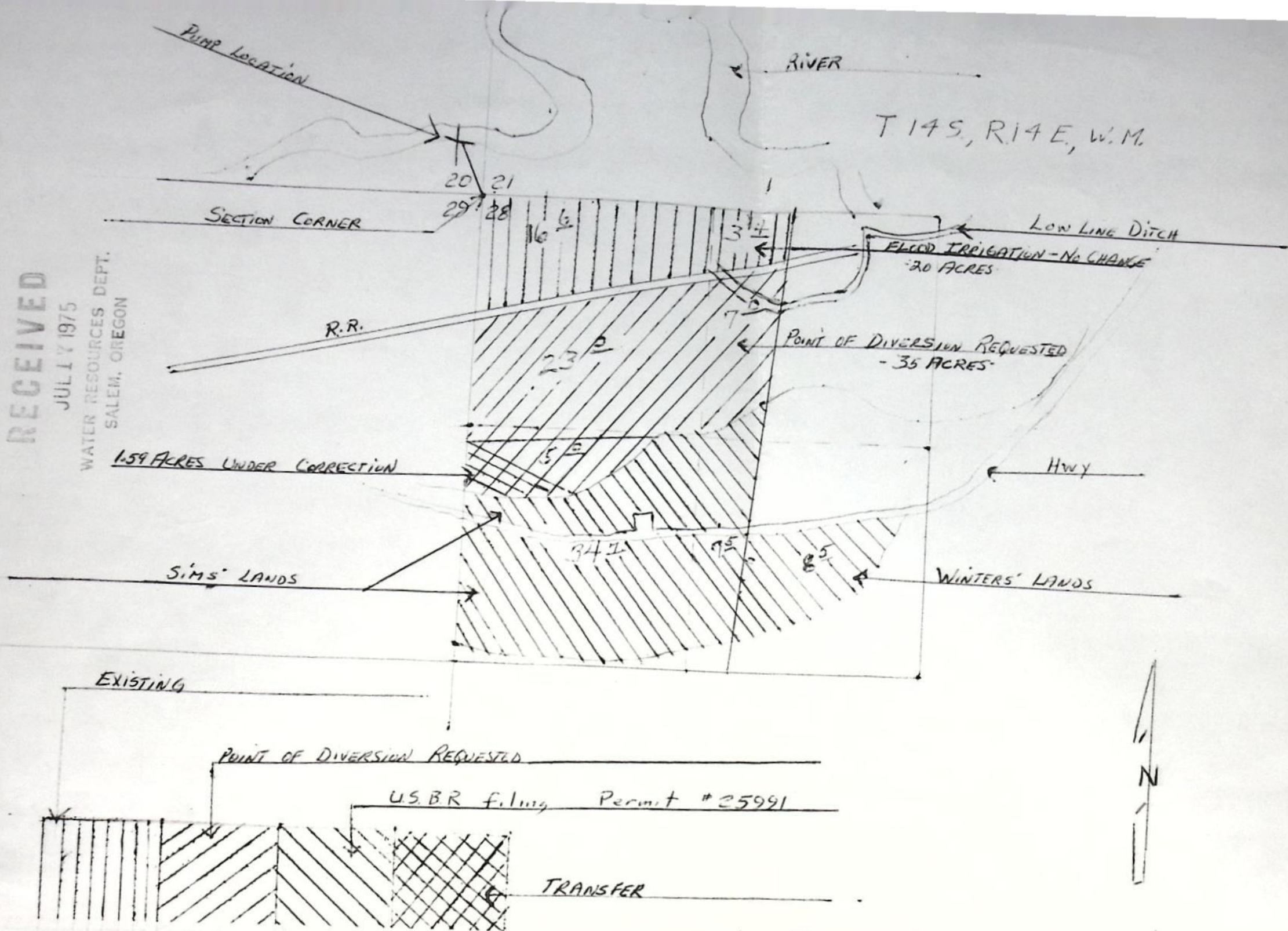

Dear Ms. Sims:

Your application for a change in point of diversion of water from Crooked River received in July of 1975 was filed as transfer No. 3286. A tracing and two prints of a map along with the copy of right of way agreement and fees in the amount of \$32.00 were also received.

I do not understand your proposed transfer of 1.59 acres from the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 28. According to our records, there is an existing right to the use of water from Crooked River for the irrigation of the 40 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$. Your map indicates that 16.6 acres will be irrigated from the original point of diversion and 23.0 acres will be supplied water from the new point of diversion requested. The map also shows a railroad through the area. Any right that may have been appurtenant to the railroad lands would be considered lost due to non-use. If you wish to transfer a water right, only a valid right can be transferred and it will be necessary for you to show on your map the area to be divested of the water right.

Your application requires an examination fee of \$20.00. In addition to the examination fee, recording fees are also required. The recording fee for a change in point of diversion is \$15.00 and the recording fee for a change in place of use of less than 30.0 acres is \$10.00. Therefore, the application as presently prepared requires an additional \$12.90.

Since the change in point of diversion is greater than one-quarter mile, notice of the intended change must be published in a newspaper having general circulation in your county. For this we require a deposit of \$45.00. Any difference between the actual cost and the deposit will be refunded.

I am returning your application and the tracing of the map for completion. I apologize for the delay in responding to your application. Upon receipt of the properly completed application, map, additional fees, and deposit, we will prepare the notice for publication.
