ORDER APPROVING
TRANSFER NO. 3324

On October 14, 1975, Robert M. and Marvel C. Storey and Raymond G. and Janet C. Edholm filed an application in the office of the Water Resources Director for approval of changes in place of use and point of diversion of water from East Fork Evans Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

Certificate of water right issued to W. H. Pattillo and recorded at page 16153, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of 0.65 cubic foot per second of water from East Fork Evans Creek and supplemental supply from Spignet Creek for irrigation of, among other lands, 7.0 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and 6.0 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 24, Township 34 South, Range 3 West, W.M., with a date of priority of 1892 for use from East Fork Evans Creek and with a date of priority of 1871 for use from Spignet Creek. Water for this use is diverted from two points on East Fork Evans Creek located (1) 2000 feet South and 4400 feet East from the Northwest corner of Section 19, being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 19, Township 34 South, Range 2 West, W.M., and (2) 430 feet North and 1380 feet East from the center corner of Section 24, being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 24, Township 34 South, Range 3 West, W.M., and from one point on Spignet Creek, located 340 feet South and 220 feet East from the Northwest corner of Section 19, being within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 19, Township 34 South, Range 2 West, W.M.

The applicants herein, owners of the lands above described, propose to transfer the water right, without loss of priority, from 1.5 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and 3.0 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ to another 1.5 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and 3.0 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 24, Township 34 South, Range 3 West, W.M., and to irrigate these lands, together with the remaining 5.5 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and 3.0 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 24, by means of two proposed points of diversion on East Fork Evans Creek located (1) 1780 feet North and 2100 feet East from the Southwest corner of Section 24, being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 24, and (2) 980 feet North and 1000 feet East from the Southwest corner of said Section 24, being within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 24; and, also, by means of the existing point of diversion from Spignet Creek.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.510, was published in the Medford Mail Tribune, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Jackson County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of May 13, 20 and 27, 1977.

Mr. David C. Hendrix, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed changes in place of use and point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed changes in place of use and points of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested changes in place of use and point of diversion, as described herein, without loss of priority, are approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new points of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old points of diversion under the subject right, and shall not exceed 0.22 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:


That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made and said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1979.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the portion of the water right involved in the change authorized herein NOT be included in the new certificate to be issued as provided by the order entered November 3, 1977, approving transfer application No. 3764, and upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of the changes in place of use and point of diversion authorized herein, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicants herein.

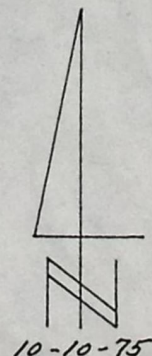

The notice of completion of works and use of water under the provisions of the order of the Water Resources Director approving water right transfer application No. 3324, for changes in place of use and point of diversion of water from East Fork Evans Creek and Spignet Creek, was received and, in line with the general practice of this office, a survey will be made at a later date.

After the survey, proof may be made and certificate of water right issued covering the actual use of water as found by the engineer. (In case of irrigation, any lands described in the order that have not been irrigated will be automatically eliminated from the water right.)

In the meantime, the order will be evidence of the water right in question as long as the authorized beneficial use of water is continued.

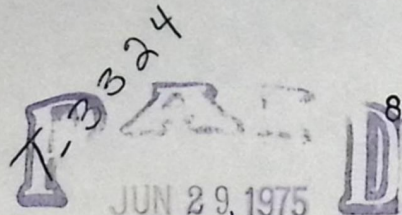

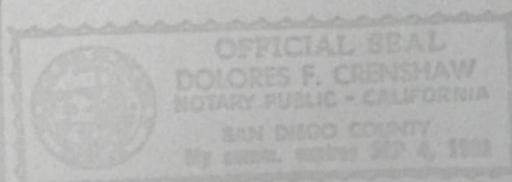
