

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3326

On October 10, 1976, Ralph Eason filed an application in the office of the Water Resources Director for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from Owyhee River pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The applicant proposes a change in point of diversion under two existing rights of record (1) as described by the certificate recorded at Page 36152, Volume 28, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Ralph and Beverly Eason, which includes the use of not to exceed 0.1 cubic foot per second from Owyhee River for the irrigation of 2.5 acres in Lot 4 (SW\(\frac{1}{2}\) SW\(\frac{1}{4}\)) and 3.4 acres in SE\(\frac{1}{2}\) SW\(\frac{1}{2}\) of Section 30, Township 31 South, Range 42 East, W.M., with a date of priority of June 29, 1942; and (2) under a right perfected under the terms of water right permit No. 36110, in the name of Ralph Eason, which right includes the use of 0.81 cubic foot per second with a date of priority of March 8, 1967, and 0.13 cubic foot per second with a date of priority of May 2, 1967, of the waters from Owyhee River for the irrigation of 37.8 acres in Lot 4 (SW\(\frac{1}{2}\) SW\(\frac{1}{2}\)) and 18.8 acres in SE\(\frac{1}{2}\) SW\(\frac{1}{2}\)

Water for the said rights is diverted from a point located 100 feet North and 1580 feet East from the West quarter-corner of Section 30, being within the SE4 NW4 of Section 30, Township 31 South, Range 42 East, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change, without loss of priority, the point of diversion and to irrigate these lands from a point of diversion to be located South 56 degrees 10 minutes East, 2455 feet from the West quarter-corner of Section 30, being within the SE¹₄ SW¹₄, Section 30, Township 31 South, Range 42 East, W.M.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.510 was published in the Malheur Enterprise, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Malheur County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of October 20, 27 and November 3, 1976.

Mr. Frank W. Elfering, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objection having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of diversion from the Owyhee River described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion, and shall not exceed 0.1 cubic foot per second with a priority date of June 29, 1942, 0.81 cubic foot per second with a priority date of March 8, 1967, and 0.13 cubic foot per second with a priority date of May 2, 1967.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1978.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to Ralph and Beverly Eason and recorded at Page 36152, Volume 28, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right not involved in this proceeding; that a certificate be issued to Ralph Eason to confirm the balance of the right established under permit No. 36110, not involved in this proceeding; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, confirming certificates of water right shall be issued to Ralph Eason.



Dear Mr. Easom:

Your application for an additional point of diversion of water from the Owyhee River received in October of 1975 was filed as transfer number 3326. The map prepared on tracing paper and fees of \$36.00 were also received.

According to the final proof made in connection with your permit No. 36110, the right was perfected for the irrigation of, among other lands, 37.8 acres in Lot 4 (SWk SWk) and 18.8 acres in SEk SWk of Section 30, Township 31 South, Range 42 East, W.M. instead of the 34.0 acres in Lot 4 and 14.0 acres in the SEk SWk listed in item No. 5 of your transfer application. If you will be irrigating all the lands in the Sk of the SWk from the new point of diversion, you may amend item No. 5.

Based on the information supplied in item 20, only the new point of diversion will be used for the irrigation of the acreage listed in item 5. If so, the application should be made for a change in point of diversion for the acreage listed instead of an additional point of diversion.

The application proposes a change greater than one-quarter mile, so notice of the intended change must be published in a newspaper having general circulation in the county. For publishing notice, we require a deposit of \$45.00. Will you also advise us of your choice of newspapers published in Malheur County.
