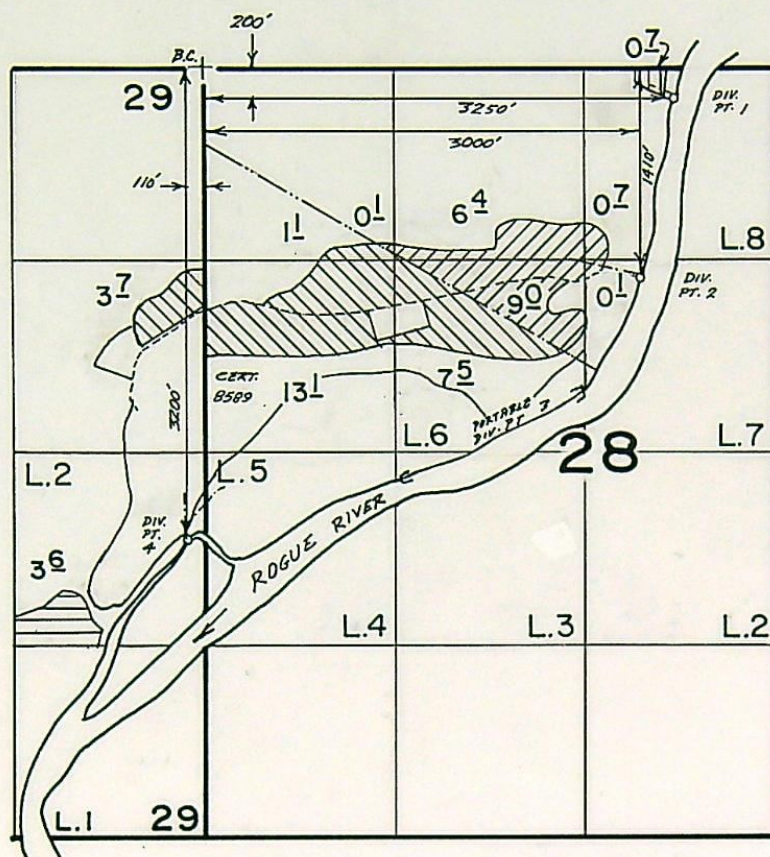

The date set for hearing in said notice was not less than thirty days after the last publication of the notice.

Mr. David C. Hendrix, Watermaster of District No. 13, has filed a report to the effect that the proposed change in place of use and points of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use and point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be carried out prior to the diverting of water at the new points of diversion as herein confirmed:

That the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled.

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificate of water right heretofore issued to Josephine Cottrell and recorded at page 8589, Volume 8, and certificate of water right heretofore issued to V. H. Vawter and recorded at page 8590, Volume 8, State Record of Water Right Certificates, are canceled and in lieu thereof new certificates be issued covering the balance of the lands not involved in this proceeding, and upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the State Engineer of completion of the authorized changes in points of diversion and place of use, a certificate of water right shall be issued to Robert E. 
