

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.510, was published in the Wallowa County Chieftain, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Wallowa County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of January 20 and 27 and February 3, 1977.

Mr. Robert W. DeBow, Watermaster of District No. 7, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objection having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of diversion from South Fork Wallowa (Lostine) River described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the rights involved herein.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install head-gates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1978.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at Page 2940, Volume 4, State Record of Water Right Certificates, involved in the change authorized herein NOT be included in the new certificate to be issued as provided by the order entered March 17, 1977, approving transfer application No. 3053; and that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to Geo.
