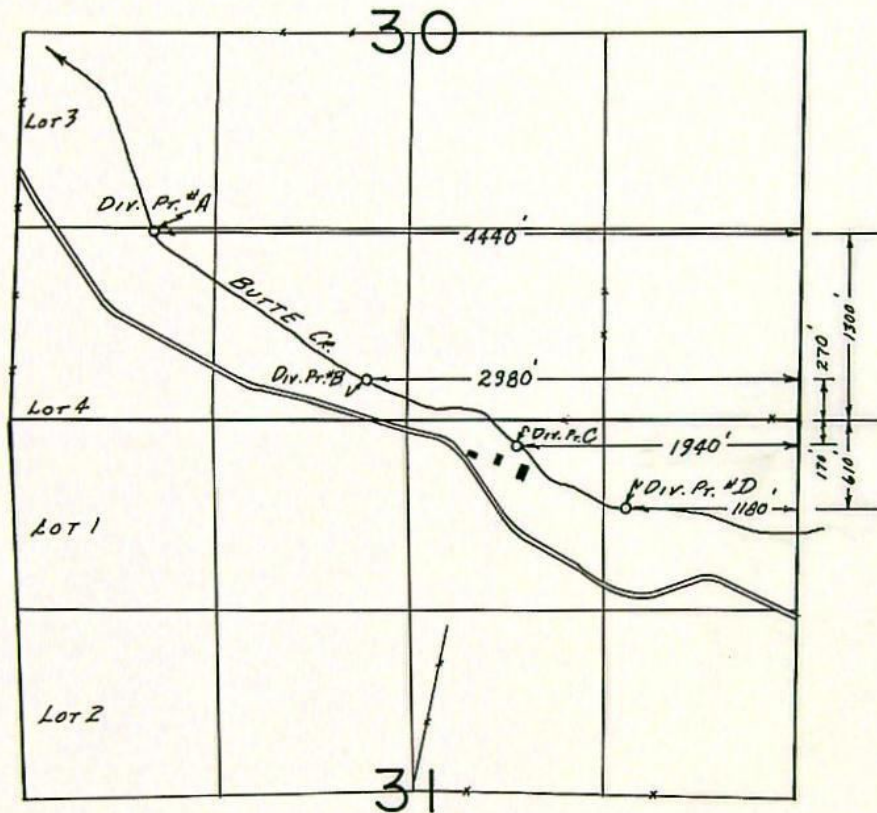

ORDER APPROVING  
TRANSFER NO. 3632

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On April 28, 1977, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Morris E. Wilson for approval of changes in point of diversion of water from Butte Creek under existing water rights of record, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 25138, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Edwards and Cooke, describes a right for the use of water from Butte Creek with a date of priority of "Spring, 1871" for irrigation of a certain 131.7 acres of land as tabulated below.

The certificate recorded at page 42567, Volume 34, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the names of Morris E. and Viola M. Wilson, describes a right for the use of not to exceed 3.13 cubic feet per second from Butte Creek within the period of October 1 to March 31, inclusive, with a date of priority of June 24, 1960, for irrigation of a certain 125.2 acres of land as tabulated below, said lands being a portion of the lands also irrigated from Butte Creek under the provisions of the right described by certificate 25138.

The certificate recorded at page 42568, Volume 34, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the names of Morris E. and Viola M. Wilson, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.93 cubic foot per second from Butte Creek with a date of priority of June 24, 1960, for irrigation of a certain 42.4 acres of land as tabulated below.

Water for said rights is diverted from Butte Creek at a point located 1800 feet South and 2070 feet East from the Northwest corner of Section 32, being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 32, Township 6 South, Range 21 East, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to establish, without loss of priority, four additional points of diversion from Butte Creek located (1) 1320 feet North and 920 feet East, (2) 180 feet North and 2700 feet East, (3) 380 feet South and 3700 feet East and (4) 520 feet South and 4060 feet East from the Southwest corner of Section 30, being within (1) SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  (2) SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of said Section 30; and (3) NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  and (4) NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 31, Township 6 South, Range 21 East, W.M.

Notice of the application, pursuant to ORS 540.510, was published in the Gilliam-Wheeler Times-Journal, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Wheeler County, Oregon, for a period of three weeks in the issues of May 12, 19 and 26, 1977.

Mr. Robert F. Main, Jr., Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.



No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested four additional points of diversion of water from Butte Creek, as described herein, without loss of priority, are approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject rights.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgement of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1979.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, the certificate of water right heretofore



issued to Edwards and Cooke and recorded at page 25138, Volume 17, and the certificates heretofore issued to Morris E. and Viola M. Wilson and recorded at pages 42567 and 42568, Volume 34, State Record of Water Right Certificates, be canceled, and in lieu thereof, three new confirming certificates of water right be issued to the applicant herein.
