

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.07 cubic foot per second,

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 22 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3846

On December 6, 1977, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Nels Severtson for approval of a change in point of diversion from Canyon Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 19652, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of John Hamlin, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second from Canyon Creek for irrigation of a certain 1.3 acres in SE4 NW4 of Section 27, Township 30 South, Range 5 West, W.M., with a date of priority of January 2, 1947.

The authorized point of diversion for said right is located 110 feet South and 420 feet West from the interior "L" corner of the J. Clark D.L.C. No. 51, being within the SE4 NW4 of Section 27, Township 30 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the point of diversion therefrom, without loss of priority, to a point located 480 feet North and 550 feet West from the interior corner of the J. Clark D.L.C. No. 51, being within the SE4 NW4 of Section 27, Township 30 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

Mr. M. John Youngquist, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of diversion as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;

That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1979.

The order approving transfer No. 3852 provided for the cancellation of the said certificate of water right recorded at page 19652, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates, and issuance of a new certificate covering the balance of the right NOT involved in the transfer proceedings; therefore,

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources
Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right
shall be issued to the applicant herein.
