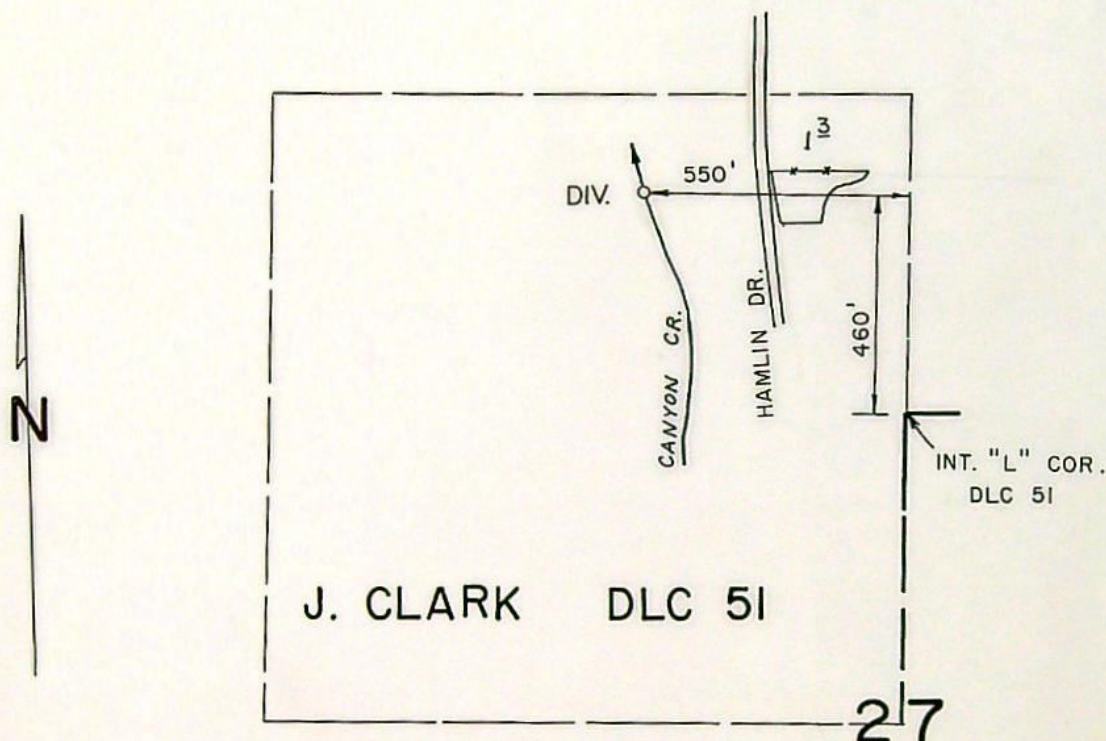

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JOHN HAMLIN

of Box 138, Canyonville, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Canyon Creek a tributary of South Umpqua River for the purpose of irrigation.

under Permit No. 17456 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 2, 1947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.07 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4, Section 27, as projected on James G. Clark DLC # 51, in Township 30 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows: 4.6 acres in SE 1/4, as projected on James G. Clark DLC No. 51

Section 27, Township 30 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that more explicitly described by appropriator as follows: 1st Deed Description No. 1 — Beginning at the S. E. corner of J. Clark DLC #51 in Sec. 27 T 30 S R5W of W.M. Douglas County Oregon, thence N 1980.0 feet to the interior L corner of said DLC, thence East 466.9 feet along the DLC line to a point marked by 1 1/2 inch pipe, thence S 7°14' E 1646.1 feet to a point marked by a 1 inch iron pipe, thence West 201.1 feet to a point marked by an 1 1/2 inch iron pipe, thence S-347.8 feet on the N line of J Reynold DLC marked by a 1 1/2 inch iron pipe, thence west 473.2 feet along said Reynolds N. line to the place of beginning containing 25.0 acres more or less.

2nd Deed Description No. 2 — All that portion of the following described property which lies east of the center of Canyon Creek. Beginning at a point 26.19 chains North and 4.05 chains West from the SE corner of James G. and Rachel Clark DLC #51, in T30 S. R5W; thence west 15.06 chains to land of A.P. Gillette; thence north 11° 50' east 4.90 chains along land of A.P. Gillette; thence north 6.35 chains to the N.E. corner of I.O.O.F. Cemetery lot; thence east 12.48 chains; thence South 73/4 degrees, east 11.25 chains to place of beginning, containing 15 acres more or less. It is intended by this deed to convey approximately three acres of land more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

ORDER APPROVING
TRANSFER NO. 3846

On December 6, 1977, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Nels Severtson for approval of a change in point of diversion from Canyon Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at page 19652, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of John Hamlin, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second from Canyon Creek for irrigation of a certain 1.3 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 27, Township 30 South, Range 5 West, W.M., with a date of priority of January 2, 1947.

The authorized point of diversion for said right is located 110 feet South and 420 feet West from the interior "L" corner of the J. Clark D.L.C. No. 51, being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 27, Township 30 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the point of diversion therefrom, without loss of priority, to a point located 480 feet North and 550 feet West from the interior corner of the J. Clark D.L.C. No. 51, being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 27, Township 30 South, Range 5 West, W.M.

Mr. M. John Youngquist, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in point of diversion as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the old point of diversion under the subject right, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the following provisions shall be effective when in the judgment of the watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

That the diversion works shall include an in line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the applicant is entitled;


That the type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said watermaster.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the construction work shall be completed and the change in point of diversion of water made on or before October 1, 1979.

The order approving transfer No. 3852 provided for the cancellation of the said certificate of water right recorded at page 19652, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates, and issuance of a new certificate covering the balance of the right NOT involved in the transfer proceedings; therefore,

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicant herein.
